

To consider the further operationalization of the platform, including:

the establishment of a facilitative working group, which would not be a negotiating body under the Convention, and the modalities for the development of a workplan for the full implementation of the functions, with balanced representation of local communities and indigenous peoples and Parties

The COP requested the SBSTA to conclude its considerations by making recommendations to COP 24 (December 2018)
