HEALTH ACTIONS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PARIS AGREEMENT

WHO launch of special initiative on health and climate change in small island developing states

Sunday 12 November, at the United Nations Climate Change Conference, WHO Director-General and UNFCCC Executive Secretary will announce an new initiative to protect the health of some of the world's most vulnerable people from the impacts of climate change. The keynote address with be given by Arnold Schwarzenegger.

The initiative aims to boost political, scientific and financial support for addressing the effects of climate change on health in small island developing states.

Small Island Developing States are in the front line, encompassing the range of acute and long-ter m risks, from more extreme floods and storms to increased risks of water-borne and food-borne disease, to sea level rise threatening healthcare facilities situated in coastal areas.
