**Title:** Estimates of emission reductions from policies and measures and projections

**Question From Party:** Japan

**Question raised on:** 07.04.2026 CEST

**Question Category:** Mitigation actions, policies and measures supporting NDC implementation

**Question:** On page 230 of BTR1, it is noted that the flexibility has been applied regarding the reporting of emission reductions from policies and measures and estimates of projections, and that improvements are planned for BTR3. What specific improvement measures are planned to enhance the technical capacity required to prepare this information?

**Answer:**

In BTR1 (page 230) Azerbaijan applied some flexibilities under paragraphs 85, 92 (MPG) due to the limited technical capacity of the country to provide estimation of the expected and achieved GHG emission reductions for the actions, policies and measures (P&M), as well as to provide the WM and other scenario projections.

Taking into account the commitment in BTR1 to address the mentioned flexibilities till BTR3 in 2028, the Republic of Azerbaijan plans to organize the necessary trainings to the staff of the Climate Change and Meteorological Studies Center of the National Hydrometeorological Service of the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources of the Republic of Azerbaijan (MENR), Climate Policy Division of MENR, as well as for the relevant experts from the line ministries, other climate data providers to enhance technical expertise capacity of the country to collect all the accurate information on actions, policies and measures (P&M) in tabular format, to use sectoral specific modelling tools (TIMES, LEAP, Ex-Ante Carbon-balance Tool), to provide ex-ante and ex-post data analysis of emission reductions, at least WM scenario projections, in order to comply with the relevant "shall" and other requirements of the paras 85, 92 and other paragraphs of MPG.
