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**Title:** Capacity-building for ETF implementation

**Question From Party:** Canada

**Question raised on:** 08.04.2026 CEST

**Question Category:** Reporting related capacity-building needs

**Question:** How has transparency capacity-building support, notably from the Initiative for Climate Action Transparency (ICAT), helped your country with ETF implementation? How does your country plan to build on your successes in ETF implementation so far? Are there specific capacity gaps that your country is prioritizing?

**Answer:**

The Initiative for Climate Action transparency (ICAT) has supported the operationalization of the Mau NDC registry which is an online MRV platform to track the impacts of climate policies and measures, and support needed and received, towards the achievement of nationally determined contributions (NDC) targets. The capacity building support received through the ICAT project has trained stakeholders on how to translate outcomes and interventions from the various sectors into indicators and how these are related to the ETF. The capacity of the stakeholders has also been built on how to present data on the platform through a walk through exercise enabling them to have a deeper understanding of the functionalities of the platform, which is now more user friendly.

The various stakeholders have now a profound understanding on how the data provided in the Mau NDC registry are linked to the monitoring of NDC implementation thereby contributing to the preparation of the next Biennial Transparency Report.

As a way forward, the GHG inventory component is planned to be integrated in the Mau NDC registry. Under the Capacity Building Initiative for Transparency project (CBIT), excel sheets are presently under development to facilitate conversion of raw and processed data into the format required for data entry into the IPCC Inventory software. Avenues are being explored on how to integrate these excel sheets in the Mau NDC registry.

Specific capacity gaps prioritized include documentation system for QA/QC implementation plan, methodologies, assumptions, and techniques used to extrapolate missing activity data and undertake uncertainty assessment, development of land use matrix, as well as understanding the different requirements of the MPGs.

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
