The event will focus on economic diversification in accordance with the outcomes of the 48th session of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice.¹

Policymakers and practitioners will share key principles and lessons learned from climate change adaptation and development planning, including Nationally Determined Contributions and National Adaptation Plans.
