Loan of Expert

The United Nations Climate Change Secretariat (UNFCCC) is seeking the non-reimbursable loan of the following Expert from Parties or other organizations for an initial period of one year through its Non-Reimbursable Loan (NRL) programme.

Responsibilities

The Expert will perform tasks under the direct supervision of the Team Leader of the Policy and Analysis Unit and the general guidance from the Manager of the Climate Finance and Sub-Programme.

The Expert will perform the following duties:

- Provide technical support to the work of the Paris Committee on Capacity-building (PCCB), particularly as it relates to the implementation of the Committee's rolling work plan.
- Undertaking technical work on matters relating to the identification of capacity-building needs and gaps in developing countries and ways and means to enhance support for capacity building in developing countries, in the context of NDCs and NAPs.
- Contribute to identifying areas of cooperation on capacity building with other programmes within the secretariat and with external stakeholders.
- Contribute to the development and implementation of capacity-building outreach activities, including through the capacity building portal.
- ✓ Support activities related to the implementation of the secretariat-wide country specialists initiative.

Qualifications & Requirements

Academic: Advanced university degree (Master's degree or higher) in economics, social sciences, environmental studies, natural sciences, engineering, development studies, or a related field.

Experience: At least five years of experience in technical aspects of capacity building in the context of climate change and/or sustainable development, with strong English drafting skills on policy and technical papers. Demonstrated record of providing technical expertise to governments or international organizations. Experience in establishing partnership and or collaborative arrangements with a wide range of stakeholders would be an advantage.

Languages: Fluency in written and oral English is required. Working knowledge of other UN official languages is an advantage.
