Summary of activities in 2018



Lima work programme on gender – decision 21/CP.22

- Support to the organisation of training and capacity-building (para 9)
 - ❑ Co-hosting Women Delegates Fund Night School training, including support to interpretation services at COP 24
 - ❑ Breakfast meeting with Heads of Delegation and NGCCFPs to provide views on capacity and support needs and share experiences on roles and responsibilities of NGCCFPs
 - ❑ NGCCFP capacity-building – webinar in November and in-person workshop at COP 24, including support to interpretation services (all six UN languages for the webinar)



Lima work programme on gender

- Annual workshop held in conjunction with SB sessions (para 11; topic per decision 3/CP.23, para 6) : in 2018, held during SBI 48
 - ❑ One day on the differentiated impacts of climate change and gender-responsive climate policy and action
 - ❑ Half day on policies, plans and progress in enhancing gender balance in national delegations

Lima work programme on gender

- Technical paper on entry points for integrating gender considerations in workstreams under the UNFCCC (para 13) – FCCC/TP/2018/1
- Gender composition report (para 19) – FCCC/CP/2018/3
- Working with NDC Partnership to enhance their knowledge products on gender and climate change tools and with the PCCB Capacity Building Portal – both to be linked to secretariat Gender and Climate Change web pages (para 25)



Gender Action Plan – decision 3/CP.23

- 6th Action for Climate Empowerment Dialogue included focus on gender considerations in all aspects of ACE implementation (GAP activity A.2)
- Including importance of travel funds in the programme of the workshop, co-hosting WDF training and networking events; supporting the travel of NGCCFPs from developing countries to participate in training workshop at COP 24 (GAP activity B.1)
- Include regular notifications to Parties at the time of elections to UNFCCC bodies the latest report on gender composition of the relevant body (GAP activity B.2):
 - The UNFCCC Membership and Elections webpage highlights the gender balance goal



Gender Action Plan – decision 3/CP.23

- ❑ The notification to Parties in May 2018 includes information on the gender composition of bodies to the UNFCCC as well as a reminder on the goal of gender balance
- ❑ Secretariat will present on the status of gender composition of bodies to the UNFCCC under the relevant agenda item at SBI 49
- Dialogue with Chairs of constituted bodies on gender integration in their respective workstreams was organized during SBI 48 (GAP activity C.1)

Gender Action Plan – decision 3/CP.23

- Capacity building to Chairs and members of UNFCCC constituted bodies and technical teams of the secretariat on integrating gender considerations in workstreams (GAP activity C.2)
 - ❑ Presented the above mandate to most UNFCCC constituted bodies
 - ❑ Undertook capacity building with Paris Committee on Capacity Building (webinar and in-person) and Adaptation Committee (in person); further capacity building sessions planned for 2019 with Technology Executive Committee and CTCN Advisory Board, Executive Committee of the WIM, CDM Executive Board, Standing Committee on Finance, LDC Expert Group



Gender Action Plan – decision 3/CP.23

- ❑ Capacity building with technical teams done in conjunction or in preparation for the sessions with constituted bodies
- UNEP DTU, CTCN, Women and Gender Constituency, UNFCCC workshop on Gender Day on Gender and TNAs; submissions also available (GAP activity D.2)
- Encourage knowledge exchange activities among the secretariat staff across all thematic areas to update work related to gender – example with the PCCB capacity building (E.4)
