Dear Ms. Acharya,

I would like to thank you for your communication dated 29 April 2026, which has been made available to the Article 6.4 Supervisory Body in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Procedure: Direct Communication with Stakeholders.

I am pleased to inform you that the Supervisory Body, at its twenty-first meeting held from 18 to 21 May 2026 in Bonn, Germany, considered your communication and agreed, on an exceptional basis, to allow the remote inspection for the programme of activities (PoA) 10415 for CPA002 covering the monitoring periods MP07 “01/06/2022 to 31/05/2024” and MP08 “01/06/2024 to 27/08/2025” with the following measures in place:

- The designated operational entity (DOE) shall apply appropriate alternative means for verification, including, but not limited to, engaging a local verifier to conduct an on-site inspection of end-users, with the aim of ensuring a high level of environmental integrity.
- The DOE shall include in the verification report details of the alternative measures, along with proper justifications, in accordance with the guidance contained in “Appendix 1: Guidance on remote inspection as an alternative means to an on-site inspection” of the “Standard: Article 6.4 validation and verification standard for PoAs.”

Please note that the granting of this exemption does not prejudice any subsequent decision on issuance, which remains subject to the applicable assessment process, including the secretariat’s evaluation of the evidence submitted by the DOE and compliance with the relevant standards, procedures and additional conditions attached to the exemption.
