2024 Forum of the Standing Committee on Finance Accelerating Climate Action and Resilience through Gender-responsive Financing

## 2–3 September 2024 Arusha, United Republic of Tanzania

I am pleased to notify admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the 2024 Forum of the Standing Committee on Finance on Accelerating Climate Action and Resilience through Gender-responsive Financing will take place from **2 to 3 September 2024**. The Forum will be hosted by the Government of Tanzania and will take place at the Arusha International Conference Centre, Arusha. Observer nominations should be communicated to the secretariat by constituency focal points. Representatives of admitted NGOs nominated by constituency focal points must register using the online registration form, which will be communicated to the nominated participants. Kindly note that, owing to the limited capacity of the venue, three representatives per constituency will be allocated to participate in-person. Constituency focal points are requested to submit their nomination list no later than 10 August 2024 via <a href="mailto:cool@unfccc.int">cool@unfccc.int</a>.

Additional observers may participate virtually. The deadline for registration for virtual participation through the constituency focal points is **20 August 2024**. In view of the need to confirm arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, registrations received after the above-mentioned deadlines may not be processed. Further details relevant to in-person and virtual participation in the meeting will be communicated directly to the registered participants.

Observers are encouraged to nominate women as participants, in accordance with decision 23/CP.18 and with a view to informing more effective climate change policy that addresses the need to promote gender balance.
