OUR SOLUTION

The Youth Negotiators Academy (YNA) through its first programme the **Climate Youth Negotiator Programme** (CYNP) is a global intergenerational programme aimed at

redressing this systemic inequality of youth representation and leadership in negotiations and decision-making. The root causes are tackled by enabling and empowering the next generation of climate negotiators with the skills, knowledge, community, networks and resources to deliver transformative change.
