The Group of 77 and China Submission on the structure of the draft decision on the Glasgow-Sharm el-Sheikh work programme on the Global Goal on Adaptation referred to in decision 7/CMA.3

SB58

The group of G77 & China wants to see the following elements reflected in the draft on the GGA framework at this SB session based on the following elements:

- 1. The Preambular text.
- 2. Capturing Progress of the Glasgow Sharm El Sheikh Work Programme 2021-2023
- 3. Establishment of the GGA framework.
- 4. We all agreed that something needs to follow, but we will provide greater clarity on this at a later time.
- 5. Additional work
- 6. Reporting instruments
- 7. Finance
- 8. Budgetary Provisions

For now, under element 3, the Establishment of the Framework, we would like to see:

3. Establishment of the framework

3.1 *Decides* to establish the framework for the global goal on adaptation, as per decision 3/CMA.4, paragraph 8;

3.2_*Decides* that the purpose of the framework is to:

- a) achieve the global goal on adaptation as per article 7, paragraph 1, of the Paris Agreement,
- b) enhance adaptation action and support [1], as per Articles 9, 10, and 11, of the Paris Agreement;
- c) contribute to reviewing the overall progress made in achieving the global goal on adaptation as per article 7.14 of the Paris Agreement,
- d) reduce the increasing adverse impacts, risks and vulnerabilities associated with climate change,
- e) recognizes that the global goal on adaptation will contribute to reducing the risk of climate change impacts in the context of the long-term temperature goal set out in Article 2, paragraph 1(a), of the Paris Agreement in line with different national circumstances, needs and priorities and in the context of sustainable development and poverty eradication.

Regarding targets:

The Group of 77 and China would like to propose a non-exclusive, non-exhaustive contribution, that is still under discussion, but we think it is important for it is captured:

- <u>Option 1.</u> A short list of targets and indicators based on dimensions including action and finance in each dimension.
- <u>Option 2.</u> A short list of targets based on dimension including action and finance in each dimension.

Also decides to establish a small ad-hoc working group with the aim to identify and/or develop a set of indicators for the targets from para X above for its consideration at SB 60 and to recommend a short list to the CMA.6

• <u>Option 3.</u> A short list of targets based on dimensions [and themes] including action and finance in each of them. Also decides to establish a small ad-hoc working group with the aim to identify and/or

develop a set of indicators for the targets from paraX above for its consideration at SB 60 and to recommend a short list to the CMA.6.

- <u>Option 4.</u> Each Party could voluntarily report on elements contained in paragraph 10 (b) of Decision 3/CMA.4 through their A-BTRs.
- Option 5: An overarching target and targets for each dimension and for each targets of Decision Paragraph 10(a) and (b) of Decision 3/CMA4 Establish an ad hoc working group /Additional work undertaken by the IPCC with the aim to develop sets of indicators for the targets under the themes and dimensions including consideration of cross cutting considerations.
- Option 6: One target and indicators per dimension to link with the themes.
- Option 7: Concise overarching targets to operationalise the Global Goal on Adaptation and sub- targets based on dimensions and themes including action and support in each of them.

Also decides to establish an ad-hoc expert working group with the aim to identify and/or develop a set of indicators for the targets from para X above for its further deliberation at SB 60, with a view that recommendations on targets and indicators be considered for adoption at CMA.6

I reiterate for the Group of 77 and China the inclusion of targets as part of the GGA framework is critical and we would like to stress the importance of moving into substantive discussion on targets.
