The objectives of the Paris Agreement can only be fully realized with business engaged as a core implementation partner. More than 800 major global corporations, with combined revenues of \$16.9 trillion, have made more than 1,300 bold commitments to act on climate change (as part of the We Mean Business coalition's Take Action campaign). They include nearly 500 companies committed to setting Science-Based Targets, aligned with the Paris Agreement.

Business representatives will bring messages around how bold commitments to reduce emissions are driving innovation, growth, risk management and growth within their businesses, and helping support governments to go further.

This session will consider what governments need from business and how governments can create enabling policies that support business to deliver further climate action, faster.
