Transparency in the Paris Agreement

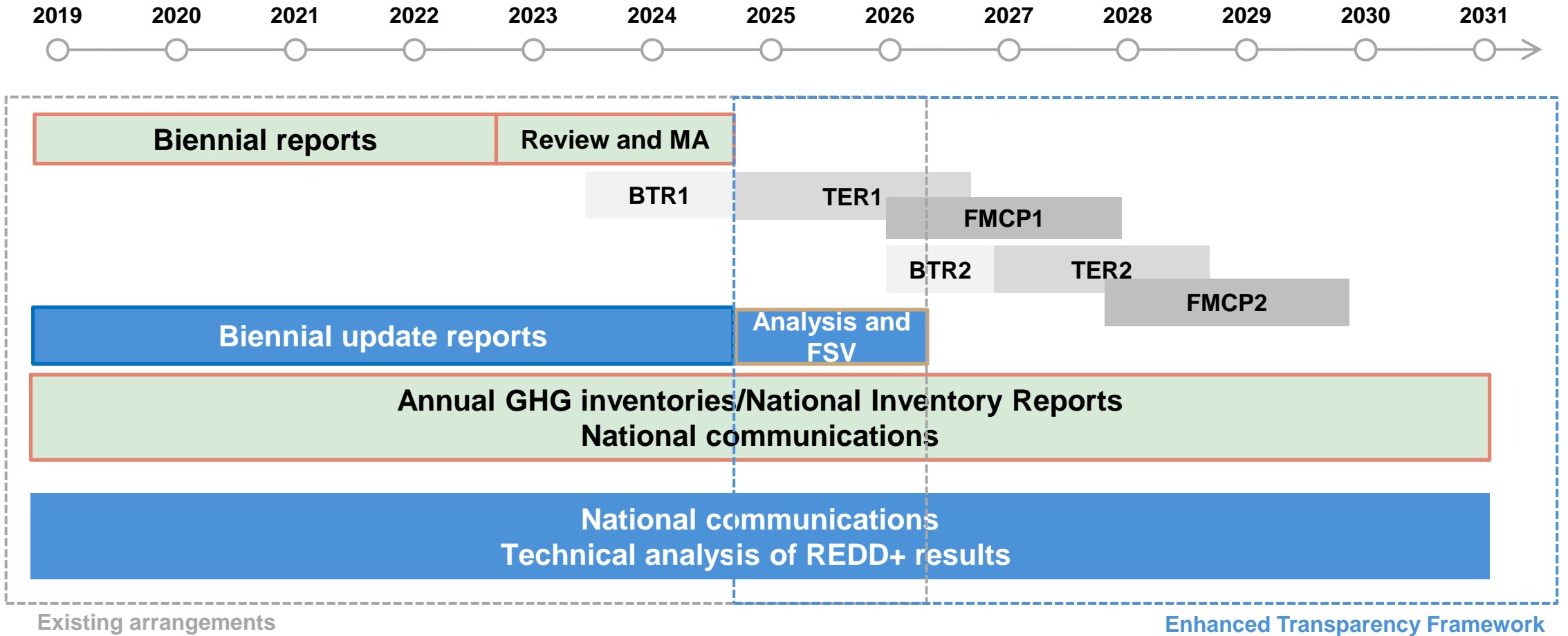
Provide a clear understanding of **climate change action** in the light of the objective of the Convention, including clarity and tracking of progress towards achieving NDCs and adaptation actions, including good practices, priorities, needs and gaps, to inform the GST

Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF) for action and support

Provide clarity on **support** provided and received by relevant individual Parties in the context of climate change actions and, to the extent possible, to provide a full overview of aggregate financial support provided, to inform the GST



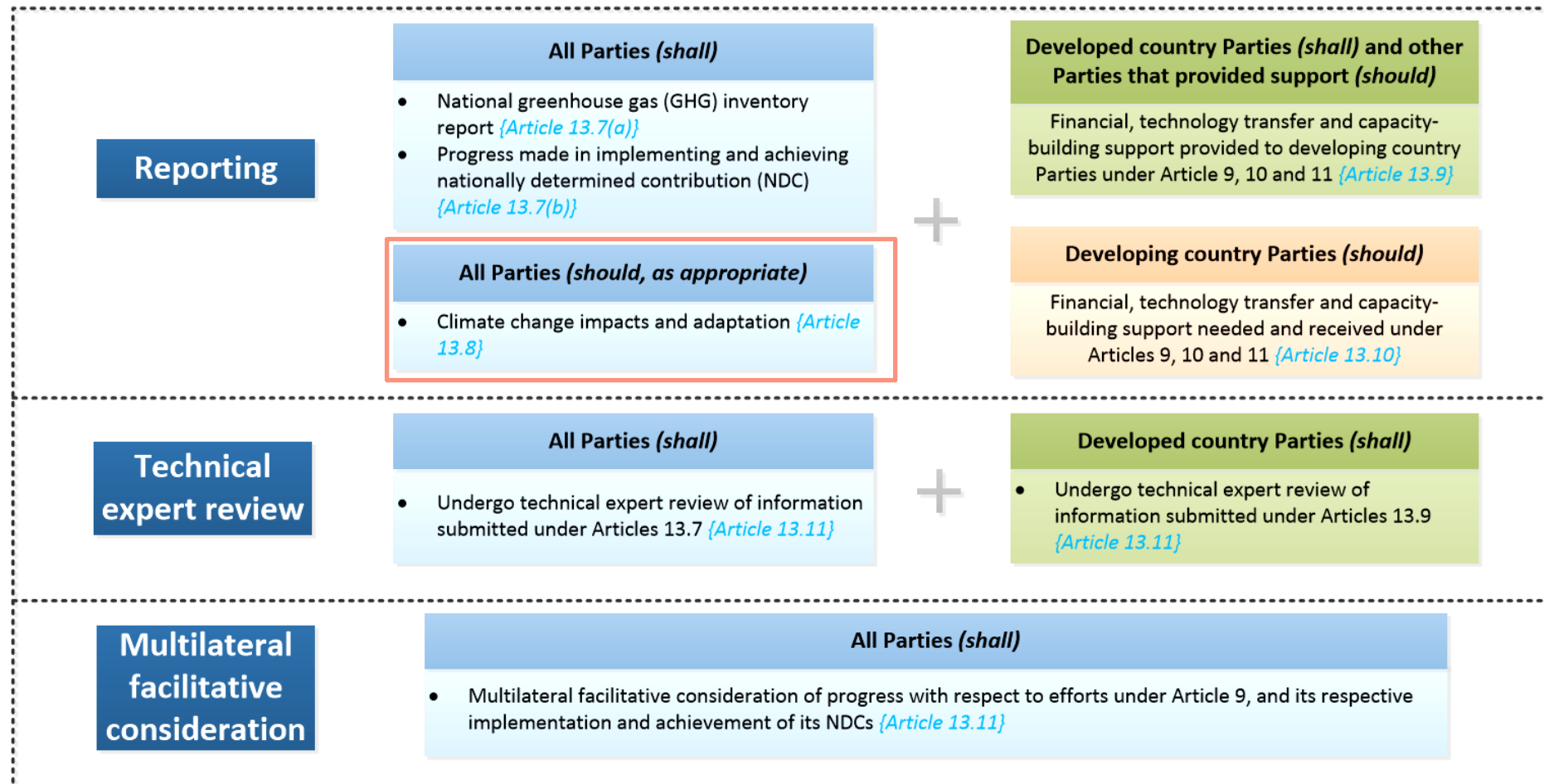
Transition from MRV to the ETF

Article 13 of the Paris Agreement: transparency of action and support



* The transparency framework shall provide flexibility in the implementation of the provisions of this Article to those developing country Parties that need it in the light of their capacities {Article 13.2};

* The transparency framework shall recognize the special circumstances of the least developed countries and small island developing States {Article 13.3}.

A. National circumstances, institutional arrangements and legal frameworks

B. Impacts, risks and vulnerabilities, as appropriate

C. Priorities and barriers

D. Adaptation strategies, policies, plans, goals and actions to integrate adaptation into national policies and strategies

E. Progress on implementation of adaptation

F. Monitoring and evaluation of adaptation actions and processes

G. Information related to averting, minimizing and addressing loss and damage associated with climate change impacts

H. Cooperation, good practices, experience and lessons learned

I. Any other relevant information

These sections can help to:

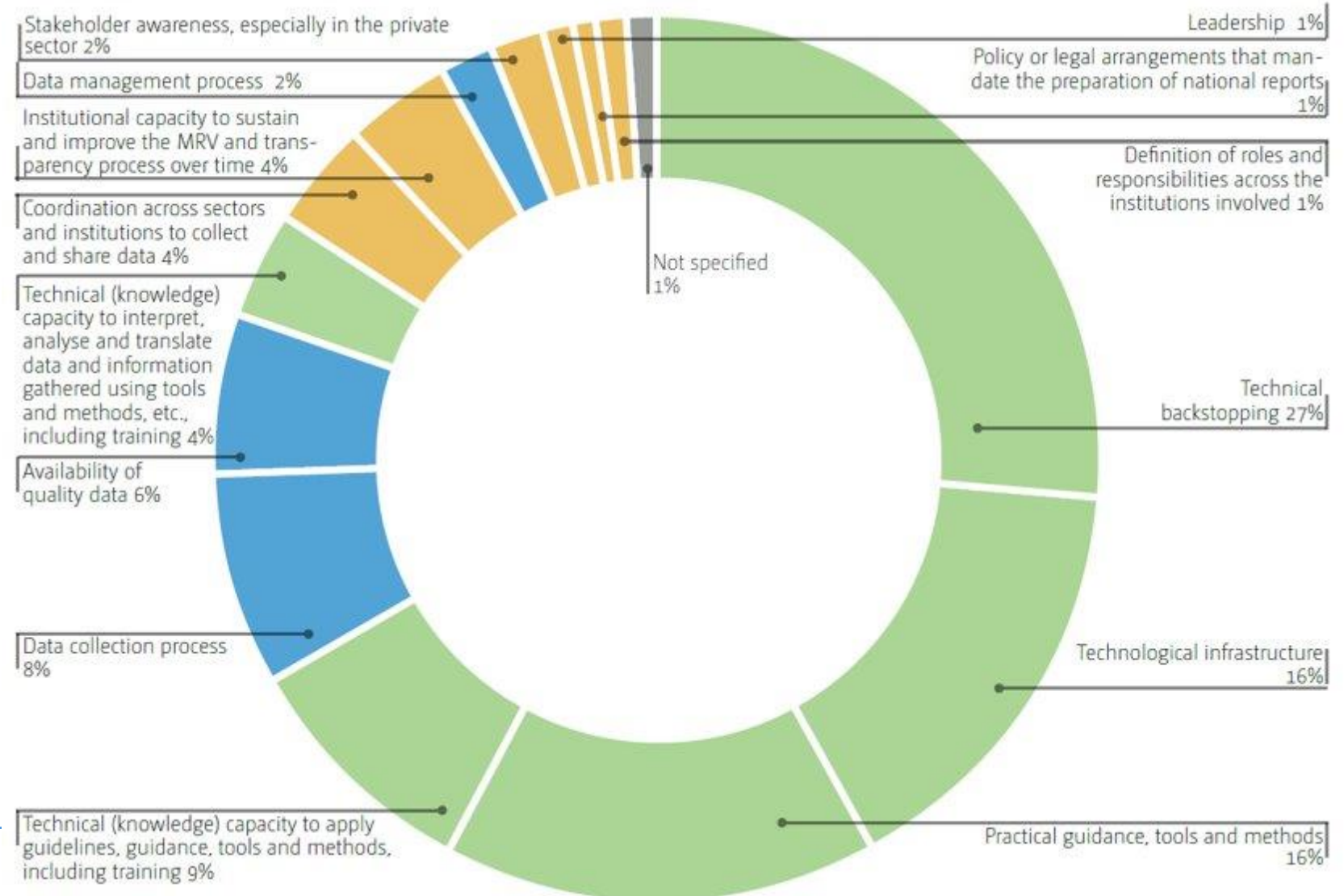
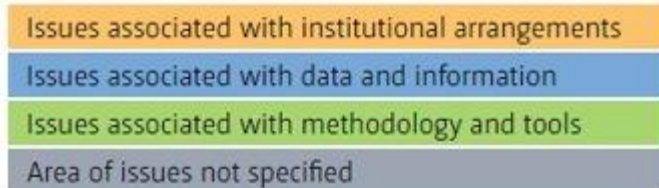
- **Identifying and gaining** recognition of adaptation efforts of developing countries;
 - **Setting the scene** or telling the adaptation story of the country, giving context to the plans, efforts and strategies;
 - **Developing the country narrative** of progress in relation to the information provided in other adaptation related instruments and planning processes;
 - **Targeting support needs** to meet adaptation priorities, including challenges, gaps, and barriers to adaptation;
 - **Providing information about good practices**, experiences and lessons learned in the implementation of adaptation actions.
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Issues associated with reporting on climate change impacts and adaptation

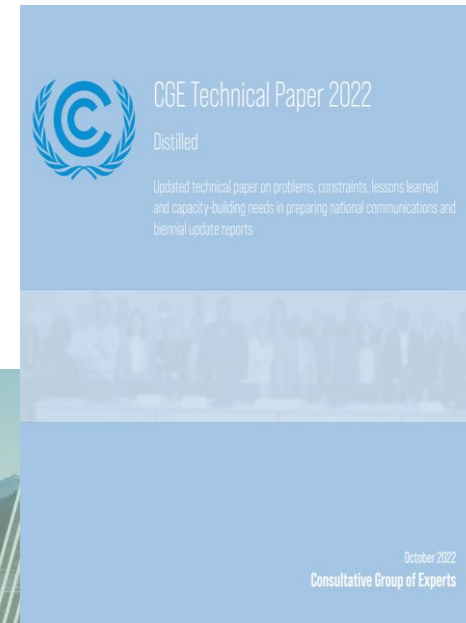
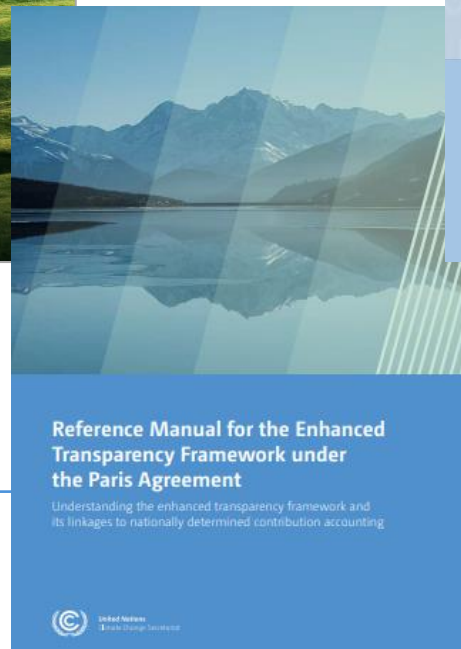
The highest three categories of issues:

- Technical backstopping – 27%
- Technological infrastructure – 16%
- Practical guidance, tools and methods – 16%
