1. Overview

The GHG Locator is an analytical tool designed to support Technical Review Officers and Technical Review Experts in the BTR review process by enabling easy querying and exploration of GHG inventory data. **Only submissions successfully ingested into the Climate Data Hub are available in this analytical tool.**

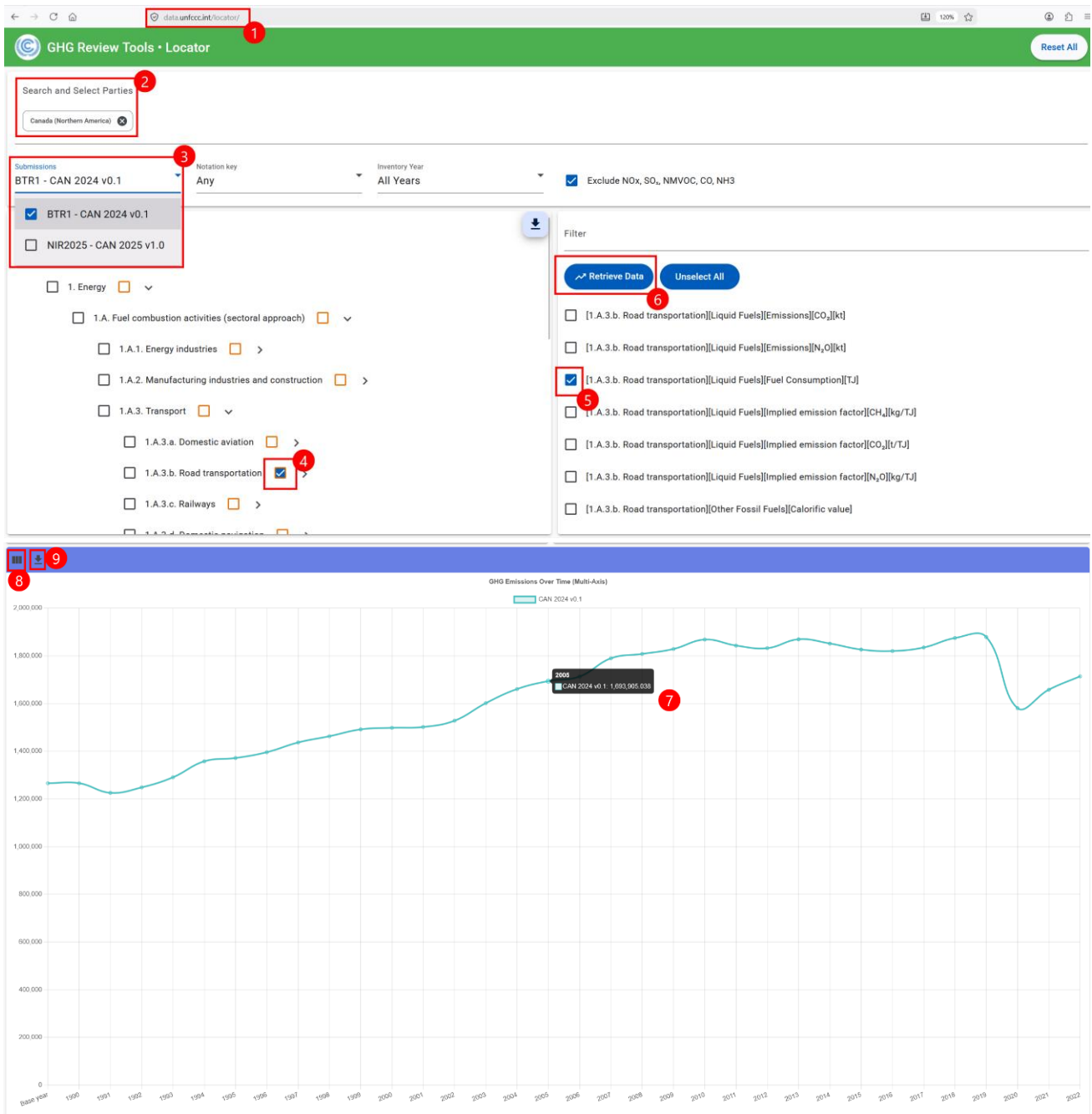

1.3 Step-by-step instructions:

1. Open the GHG Locator page
2. Select a Party
3. Select the Party's submission(s)
4. Select a category from the left window
5. Select a variable(s) belonging to the category selected from the right window
6. Click "Retrieve Data" to run the search.
7. View results in the table in the window below
8. Click on the graph icon to show the line chart
9. Download data of the search if you wish to save your data



Tips:

- "Notation Key" drop-down will list categories reported as selected NK
- "Submission" is shown as name of CRT excel files, e.g. ISO-CRT-2024 (Party ISO - CRT - Submission year)
- For new query, "Unselect All" + deselect the category on the left.
- To remove all filters, click on the "Reset All" button on the top right corner.
