Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

Option 1:

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) welcomed the reports prepared by the secretariat on national greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory data for 1990–2021 and for 1990–2022 respectively¹ and took note of the information therein.

Option 2:

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) welcomed the reports prepared by the secretariat on national greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory data for 1990–2021 and for 1990–2022 respectively² and took note of the information therein.

2. The SBI noted that, between 1990 and 2022, total aggregate GHG emissions without and with land use, land-use change and forestry decreased by 19.5 and 26.1 per cent respectively for all Parties included in Annex I to the Convention (Annex I Parties); by 44.6 and 64.0 per cent respectively for Annex I Parties with economies in transition; and by 8.8 and 10.7 per cent respectively for Annex I Parties that do not have economies in transition.³

3. The SBI expressed concern that some Annex I Parties have not yet submitted their annual GHG inventory in 2025.⁴
