Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) recalled decision 19/CMA.1 and considered the non-exhaustive lists in paragraphs 36 and 37 of that decision with a view to complementing the lists, while noting paragraphs 20, 25 and 26 of the decision.
- 2. The SBSTA took note of the exchange of views by Parties on this matter and recalled paragraph 27 of decision 19/CMA.1.
- 3. The SBSTA agreed that the non-exhaustive lists referred to in paragraph 1 above will serve as a basis for the sources and types of information for the first global stocktake.
- 4. The SBSTA also agreed that the lists referred to in paragraph 1 above can be complemented by further sources and types of information pursuant to paragraphs 2 and 6(b) of decision 19/CMA.1 with a view to achieving the outcome of the global stocktake referred to in Article 14, paragraph 3, of the Paris Agreement.
- 5. The SBSTA invited relevant constituted bodies and forums and other institutional arrangements under or serving the Paris Agreement and/or the Convention that were established after the adoption of decision 19/CMA.1, to prepare for the technical assessment of the first global stocktake, with the assistance of the secretariat, synthesis reports on the information identified in paragraph 36, taking into account paragraph 4 above, in their areas of expertise.
