- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) concluded their consideration of the first global stocktake under the Paris Agreement.
- 2. The SBSTA and the SBI agreed to forward their work on this matter as captured in the updated textual building blocks by the co-chairs of the joint contact group on the first global stocktake<sup>1</sup> for further consideration by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA) at its fifth session.
- 3. The SBSTA and the SBI noted that the updated building blocks referred to in paragraph 2 above are not an agreed text and represent work in progress. They requested their Chairs to convey the views expressed by Parties on the updated building blocks to the CMA Presidency for further consideration.
