Informed by the [synthesis report of the technical assessment](#) and taking into account the submissions and the [synthesis](#) of the submissions, this workshop, as mandated, seeks to develop elements for the consideration of the outputs component of the first global stocktake, which will inform the work of the joint contact group on the first global stocktake. The workshop is expected to allow Parties, with observer participation, to start considering the substance of what they would like a GST outcome to look like and to identify areas of convergence and those of divergence, that would benefit from further consideration.
