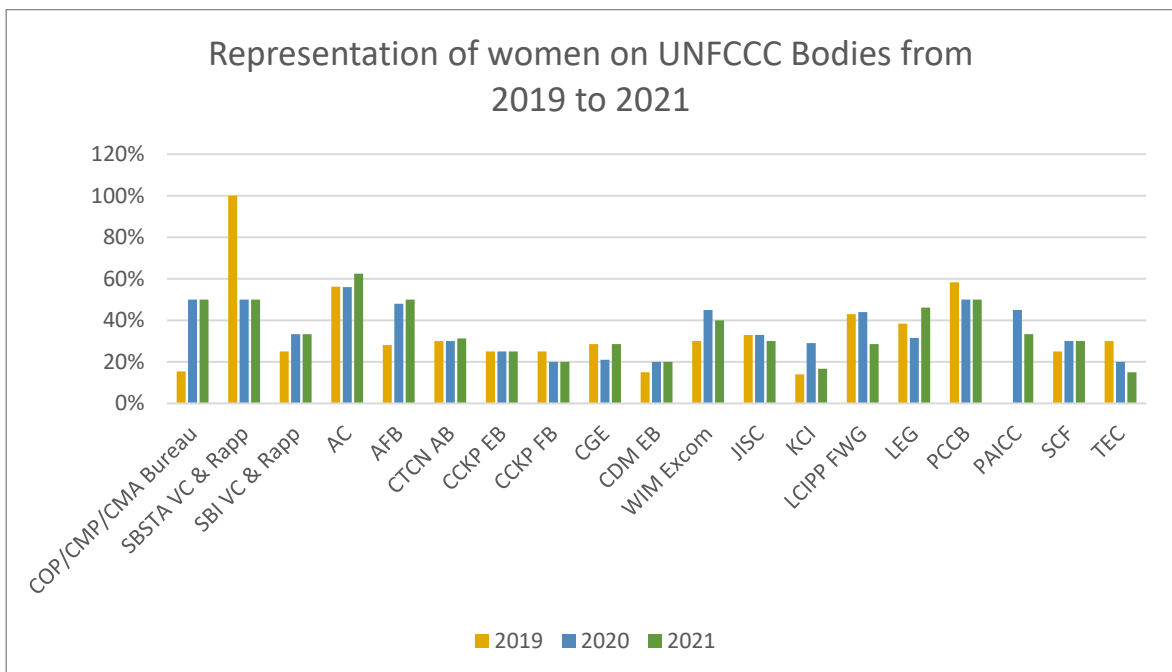
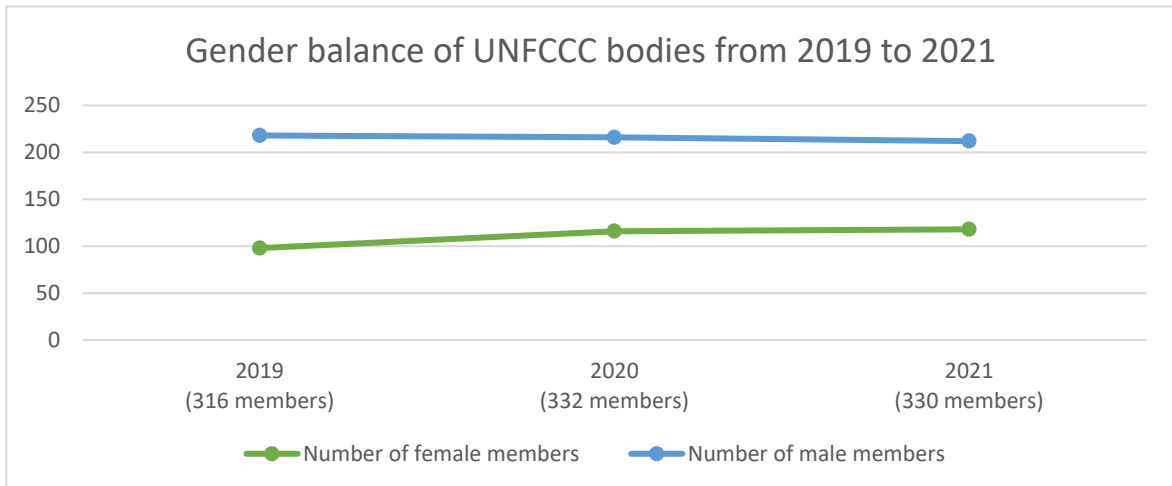




**GENDER COMPOSITION OF BODIES ESTABLISHED UNDER THE CONVENTION,
