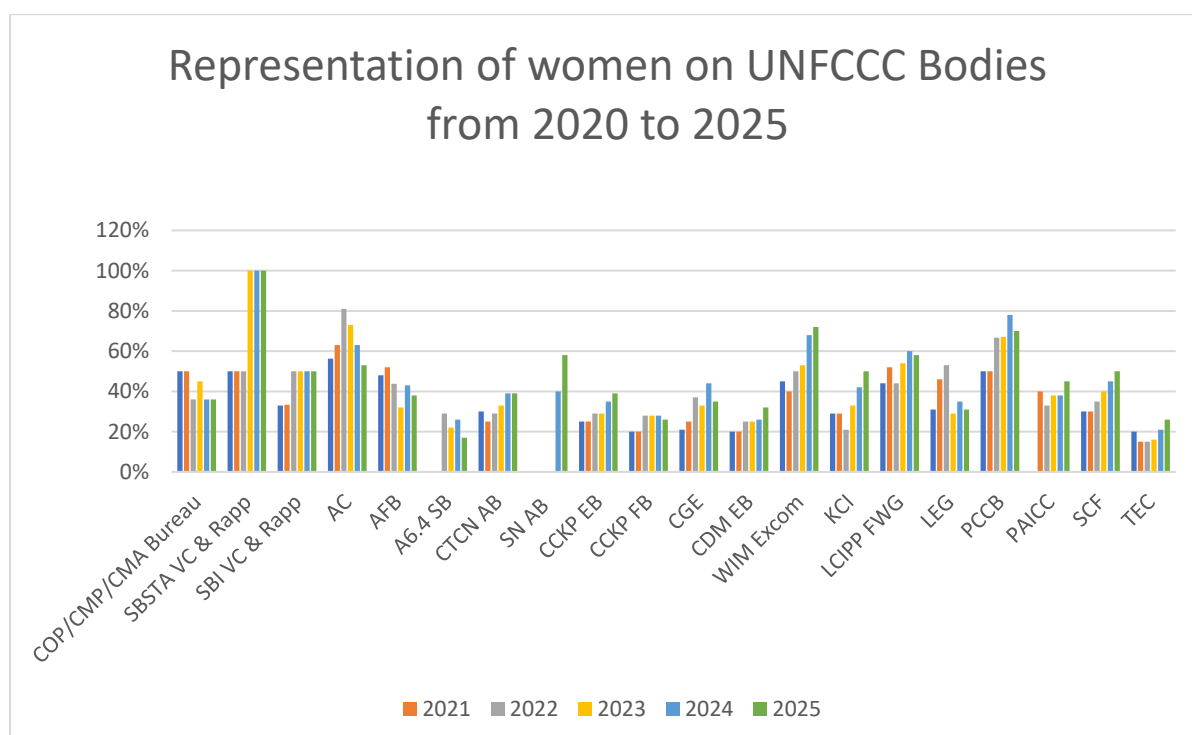
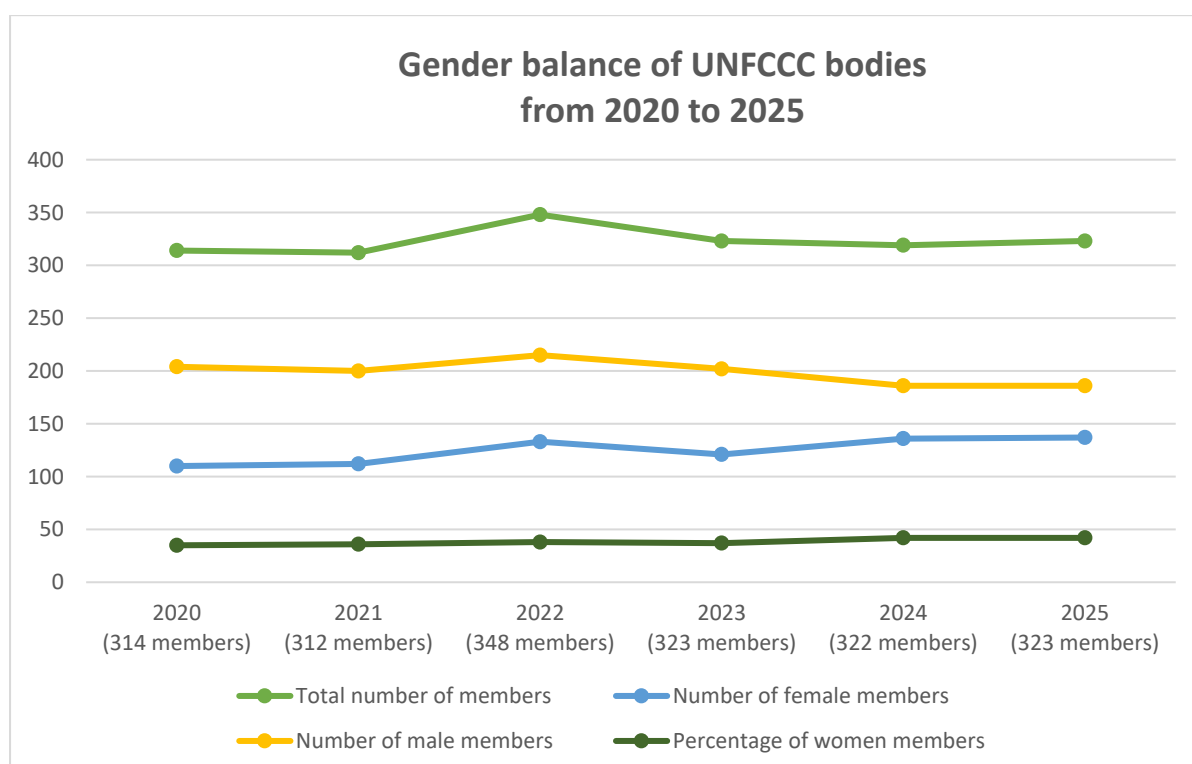

Notes

- b Membership of the bureau includes additional member from amongst Parties to the Paris Agreement.
- c The Chairs of SBSTA and SBI are members of the Bureau of the COP/CMP/CMA and, therefore, are not counted in the bureaux of the SBSTA and SBI.
- d The representatives of the Adaptation Committee, Technology Executive Committee and Standing Committee on Finance on the CTCN Advisory Board are not included in the gender composition of the CTCN Advisory Board in order to avoid double counting.
- e The representatives of the WIM Executive Committee on Loss and Damage on the Advisory Board of the Santiago Network are not included in the gender composition of the Advisory Board of the Santiago Network in order to avoid double counting.
