#### REGISTRATION

Registration desks will open at 8:15 am on the 19<sup>th</sup> floor of Langer Eugen (LEU) which is the tall building located to the right of the entrance coming in. Please bring your passport or any official identification to register. For funded participants, please bring your national passports as well as your boarding passes with you for the issuance of daily subsistence allowance.

## DAILY SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE (DSA)

DSA for Bonn = 253 USD. Exchange rate = 0.83 EUR (as of 27 April 2018)

Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA) will be disbursed based on UN rates to cover accommodation, meals, etc. Please note that DSA rates may change at the time of the meeting and participants will be advised if there are any such changes. Passport, plane/train ticket and boarding pass(es) are required to allow payment to be made.

#### HOW TO REACH THE UN CAMPUS

#### By car:

There is little space for car parking at the UN Campus. However, cars can be parked in one of the parking areas you pass along Charles-de-Gaulle-Str. Located on the back of the campus at the river side; there is a big parking space. The costs for whole day parking will be 5 Euro. A multi-story car park is located at the Karl-Carstens-Straße (entrance on the Welckerstraße); costs here are 1.50 Euro per hour or 15 Euro per day.

#### By tram/underground:

From Bonn Hauptbahnhof (main railway station):

Take underground (U-Bahn) line 16, 63 or 66 towards Bad Godesberg/Königswinter/Bad Honnef. Get of at Heussallee / Museumsmeile and take the exit "Deutsche Welle". Go straight down the Heussallee until you reach Platz der Vereinten Nationen 1 and the UN Campus.

#### From airport:

From Cologne/Bonn airport (Flughafen Koeln/Bonn):

#### Airport-shuttle-bus No SB60 towards Bonn:

Bus line "SB60" (airport express) services the 25 kilometer stretch between Cologne/Bonn Airport and the Bonn Main Railway Station. The journey typically takes approx. 30 min. At the time of writing, one-way tickets are sold at EUR 7.90.

During weekdays, the bus leaves every 30 min. During weekends, it leaves every 30-60 min., depending on the time of day. For exact timetables, please refer to the SWB Web site here: <u>https://en.swb-busundbahn.de/service/airport-express-sb60.html</u>.

From the railway station, take underground (U-Bahn) line 16, 63 or 66 towards Bad Godesberg/Königswinter/Bad Honnef.

Get of at Heussallee / Museumsmeile and take the exit "Deutsche Welle".

Go straight down the Heussallee until you reach Platz der Vereinten Nationen 1 and the UN Campus

From Frankfurt airport (Flughafen Frankfurt)

There is a fast train (Intercity train) from Frankfurt airport to Siegburg/Bonn.

From Siegburg you can take a taxi (+49228-555 555) to the UN Campus.

Alternatively, every hour there is an underground train (U-Bahn), line 66, from Siegburg to the Gronau Heussallee / Museumsmeile station.

At this station, you should take the exit "Deutsche Welle" and walk straight down the Heussallee until you reach Platz der Vereinten Nationen 1 and the UN Campus.

#### <u>By taxi:</u>

The fare for a taxi ride to Altes Abgeordnetenhochhaus/Langer Eugen (Platz der Vereinten Nationen 1) from Bonn city centre and Hauptbahnhof is around 8 Euro. The central phone number for Bonn taxis is +49228-555 555.


