REGISTRATION

Registration desks will be open at 8:30 a.m. outside of the conference room Wien 3, which is located on the entrance level of the World Conference Center Main Building. Please bring your passport or any official identification to register. For funded participants, please bring your national passports as well as your boarding passes with you for the issuance of daily subsistence allowance.

Restricted seating

Please note that, due to limited seating in the meeting room, access may be restricted to one representative per organization. Bonn Climate Change Conference (SB 50)

Although the PCCB meeting is taking place at the same time as SB 50, they are separate events. To take part in any of the SB 50 events, separate registration (via national focal point or designated contact person) is required.

DAILY SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE (DSA)

DSA for Bonn = 253 USD. Exchange rate = 0.89 EUR (as of 27 May 2019)

Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA) will be disbursed based on UN rates to cover accommodation, meals, etc. Please note that DSA rates may change at the time of the meeting and participants will be advised if there are any such changes. Passport, plane/train ticket and boarding pass(es) are required to allow payment to be made.

HOW TO REACH THE WORLD CONFERENCE CENTER

By car:

The World Conference Center is located at Platz der Vereinten Nationen 2, 53113 Bonn, Germany

A map of venue can be found in Annex I below.

The World Conference Center Bonn encompasses the Main Building together with the Plenary Building. The meeting venue, conference room 'Wien 3', is located on the entrance level of the World Conference Center Main Building.

Multi-storey car park:

A multi-story car park is located at the Karl-Carstens-Straße, 53113 Bonn (entrance on the Welckerstraße, please enter Welckerstrasse as the address in your navigation device). The parking charge is 1,50 Euro per hour. At the pay stations you can pay with EC or credit cards. A day ticket is 15 Euro. On the street level, there are 10 disabled parking spaces.



By tram and bus:

Tram from Bonn Hauptbahnhof (Bonn Central Station):

Take underground (U-Bahn) line 16, 63 or 66 towards Bad Godesberg/Königswinter/Bad Honnef. Alight at the Heussallee / Museumsmeile stop and follow the signs to the World Conference Center Bonn (appr. 450 metres by foot). Follow Heussallee to the junction with Platz der Vereinten Nationen and turn left. The Main Entrances of the World Conference Center Bonn are located 100 metres down the street.

Bus from Bonn Hauptbahnhof (Bonn Central Station)

You can take the busses number 610 and 611 (direction Pappelweg). Alight at the stop Deutsche Welle / Heussallee. Follow the Heussallee to the junction with Platz der Vereinten Nationen. Turn left onto Platz der Vereinten Nationen. The Main Entrances of the World Conference Center Bonn are located 100 metres down the street.

From airport:

From Cologne/Bonn airport (Flughafen Koeln/Bonn):

Airport-shuttle-bus No SB60 towards Bonn:

Bus line “SB60” (airport express) services the 25 kilometers stretch between Cologne/Bonn Airport and the Bonn Main Railway Station. The journey typically takes approx. 30 min. At the time of writing, one-way tickets are sold at EUR 7.90.

During weekdays, the bus leaves every 30 min. During weekends, it leaves every 30-60 min., depending on the time of day. For exact timetables, please refer to the SWB Web site here: <https://en.swb-busundbahn.de/service/airport-express-sb60.html>.

From the central station, take underground (U-Bahn) line 16, 63 or 66 towards Bad Godesberg/Königswinter/Bad Honnef.

Alight at the Heussallee / Museumsmeile stop and follow the signs to the World Conference Center Bonn (appr. 450 metres by foot).

Follow Heussallee to the junction with Platz der Vereinten Nationen and turn left.

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From Frankfurt airport (Flughafen Frankfurt)

There is a fast train (Intercity train) from Frankfurt airport to Siegburg/Bonn.

From Siegburg you can take a taxi (+49 228-555 555) to the UN Campus.

Alternatively, every hour there is an underground train (U-Bahn), line 66, from Siegburg towards Bad Godesberg/Königswinter/Bad Honnef.

Alight at the Heussallee / Museumsmeile stop and follow the signs to the World Conference Center Bonn (appr. 450 metres by foot).

Follow Heussallee to the junction with Platz der Vereinten Nationen and turn left.

The Main Entrances of the World Conference Center Bonn are located 100 metres down the street.

By taxi:

To go to World Conference Center (Platz der Vereinten Nationen 2) from Bonn Central station and city centre, the fare for a taxi ride is around 9,50 Euro and travel time would be around 10 minutes.

There is one ATM machine (Euronet – Geldautomat) located between two buildings of the World Conference Center. Another ATM can also be found at the above-mentioned post office.

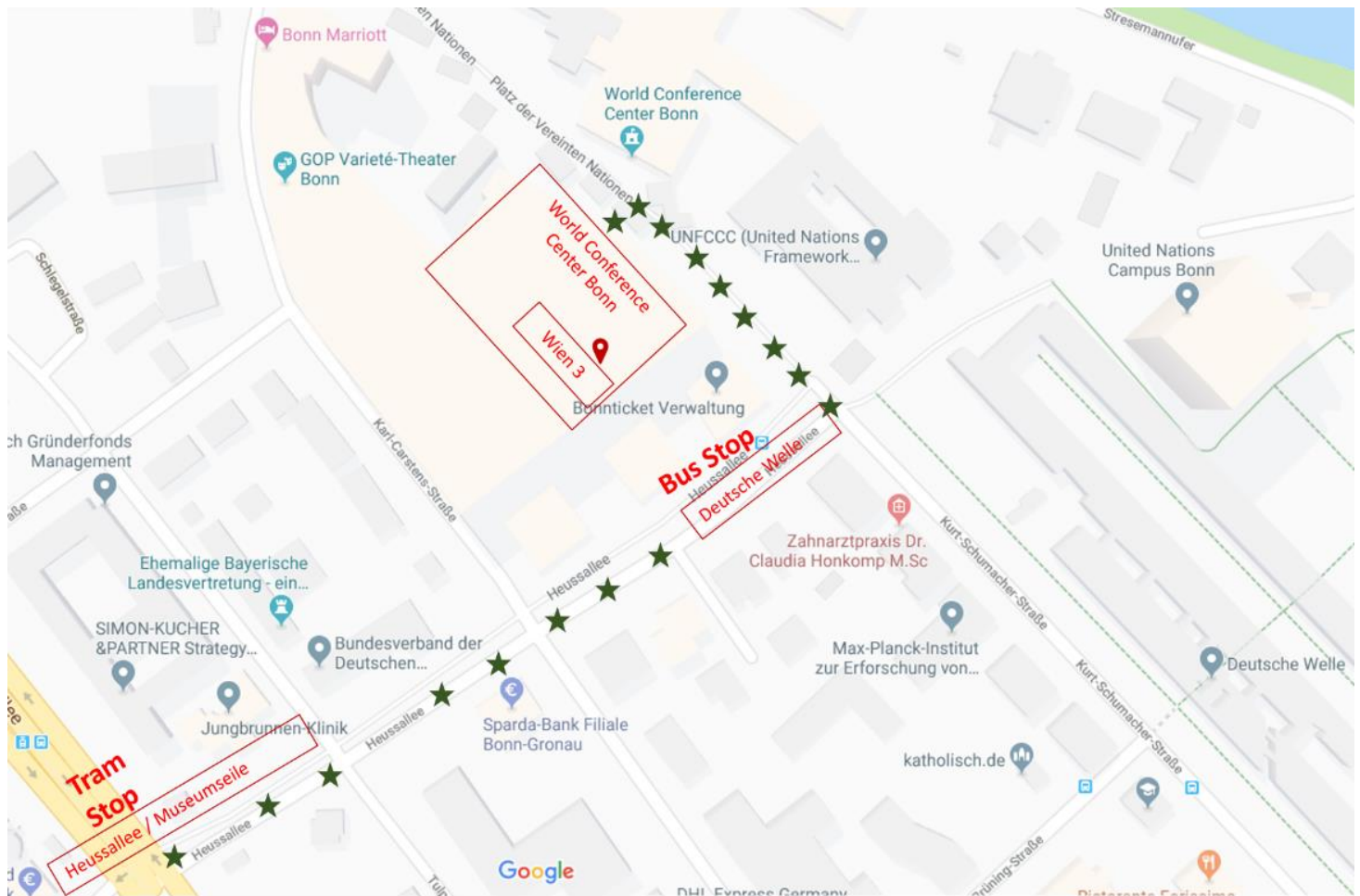
