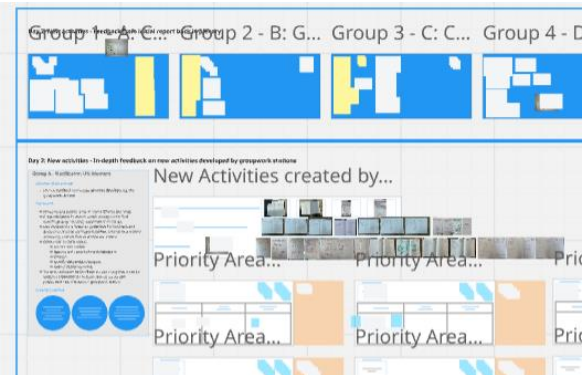

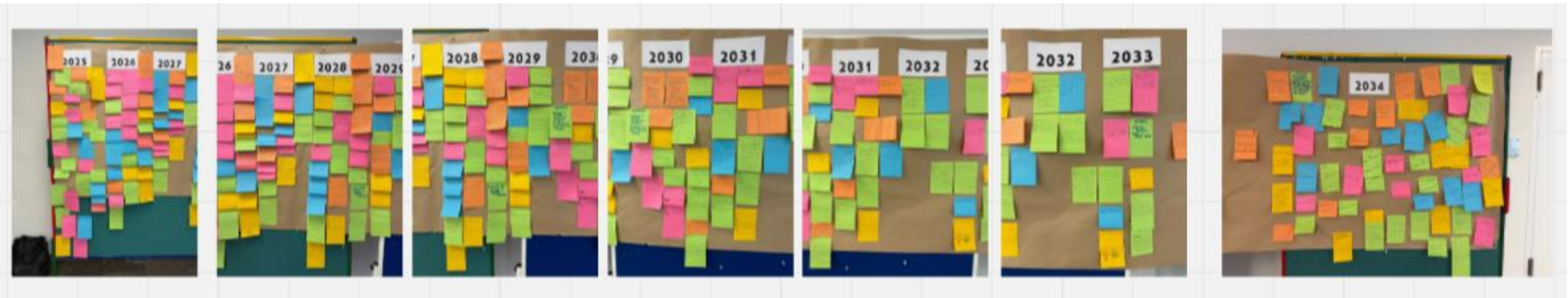

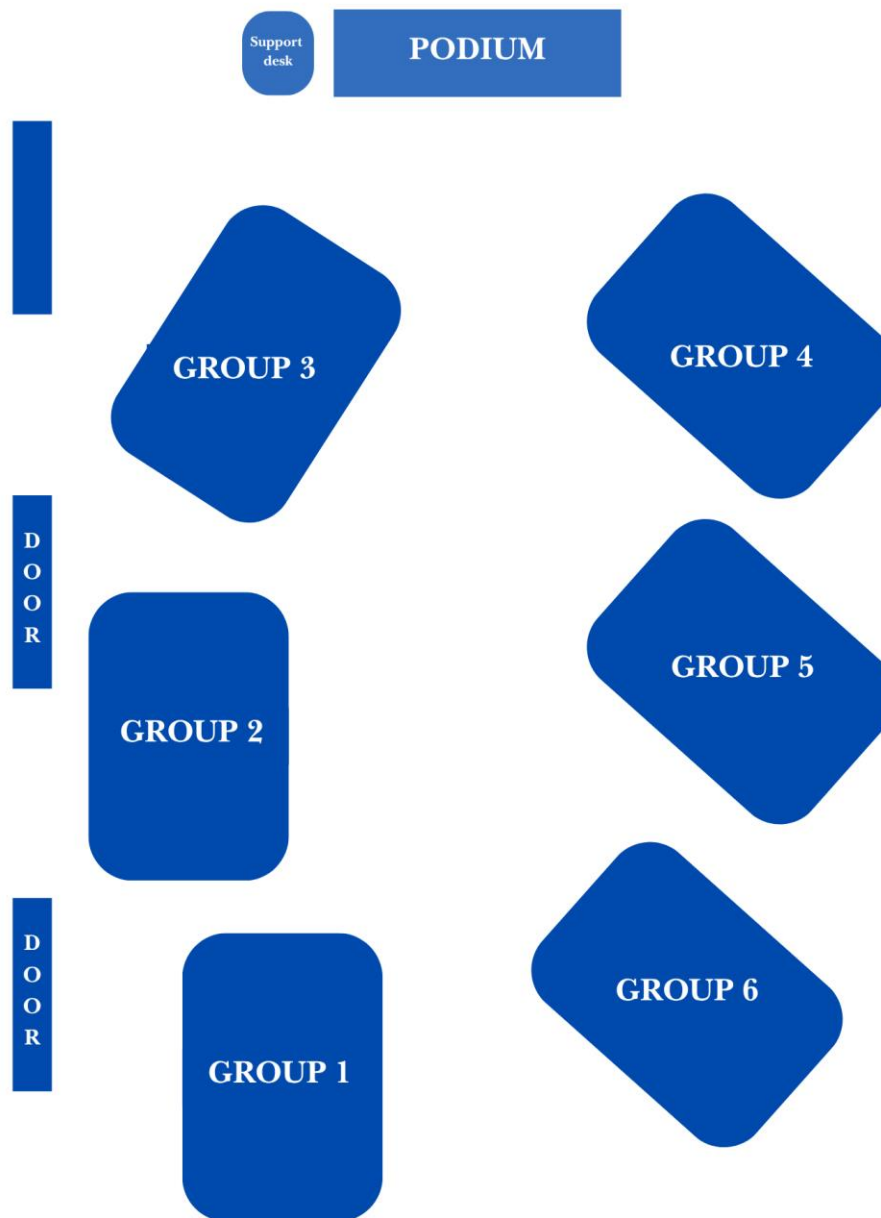

- **Three clockwise rotations**

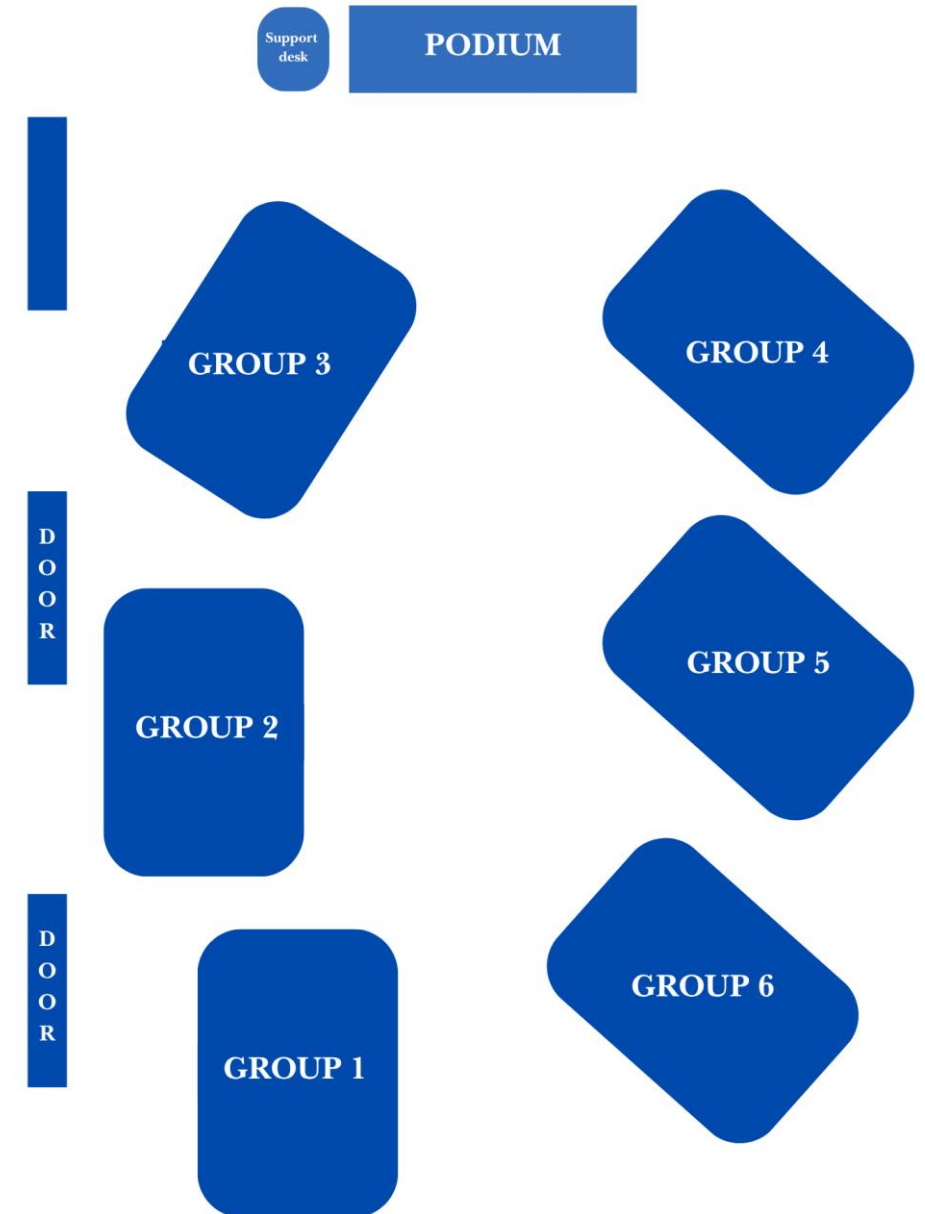
- The whole group rotates together to the same station

- **Group 3:**
  - Do we have national gender focal points for all the Rio Convention Secretariats?
  - How can we engage with Presidencies to ensure gender balance in the Presidency team?
  - Gender integration in NDCs: Who will look into it? The Secretariat or SB chairs would be in the best position?
  - Is there any better splitting possible for an outcome/deliverable for splitting on Indigenous people and local communities, as outcome / deliverable is on LCIPP?
  - How to track how gender was discussed across the other negotiations tracks?
- **Group 5:**
  - Activity 1 (*Collaborate with constituted bodies implicated in finance, tech and capacity building to advance gender-responsive*), timeline (dialogue every two years) to be checked by the Secretariat.
  - Can we open funding windows: maybe finance discussion, taking place in the finance room?
  - It should be possible to send a recommendation to the group providing guidance to GEF and GCF (other agenda item). Question for secretariat: can this be done through a formal channel? Or informally?
  - How do we explore linkages with the technology workstream, capacity building, JT...?
  - Is there a portal on access to finance
- **Group 6:**
  - Where does participants' data come from [*in the Gender composition report*]?
- **Online group:**
  - How to engage countries without a NGCCFP?
  - Can the GAP address subnational entities? Or is it limited to party level?

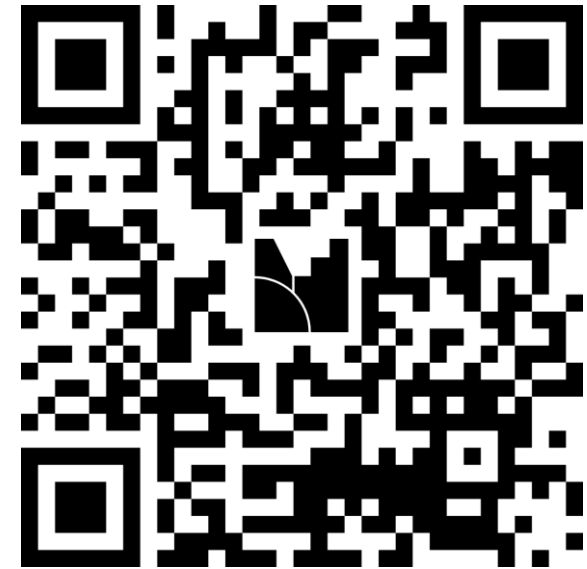
