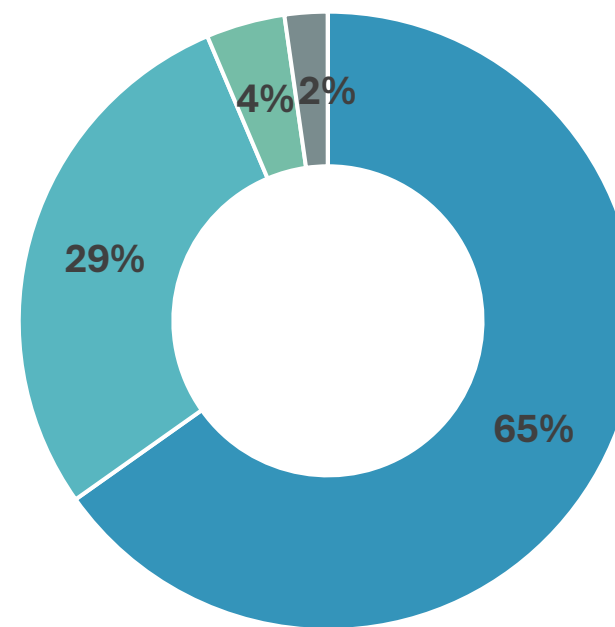
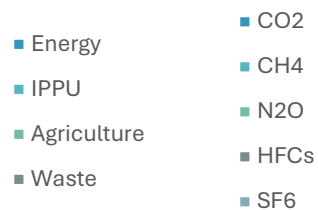


Share of Emissions

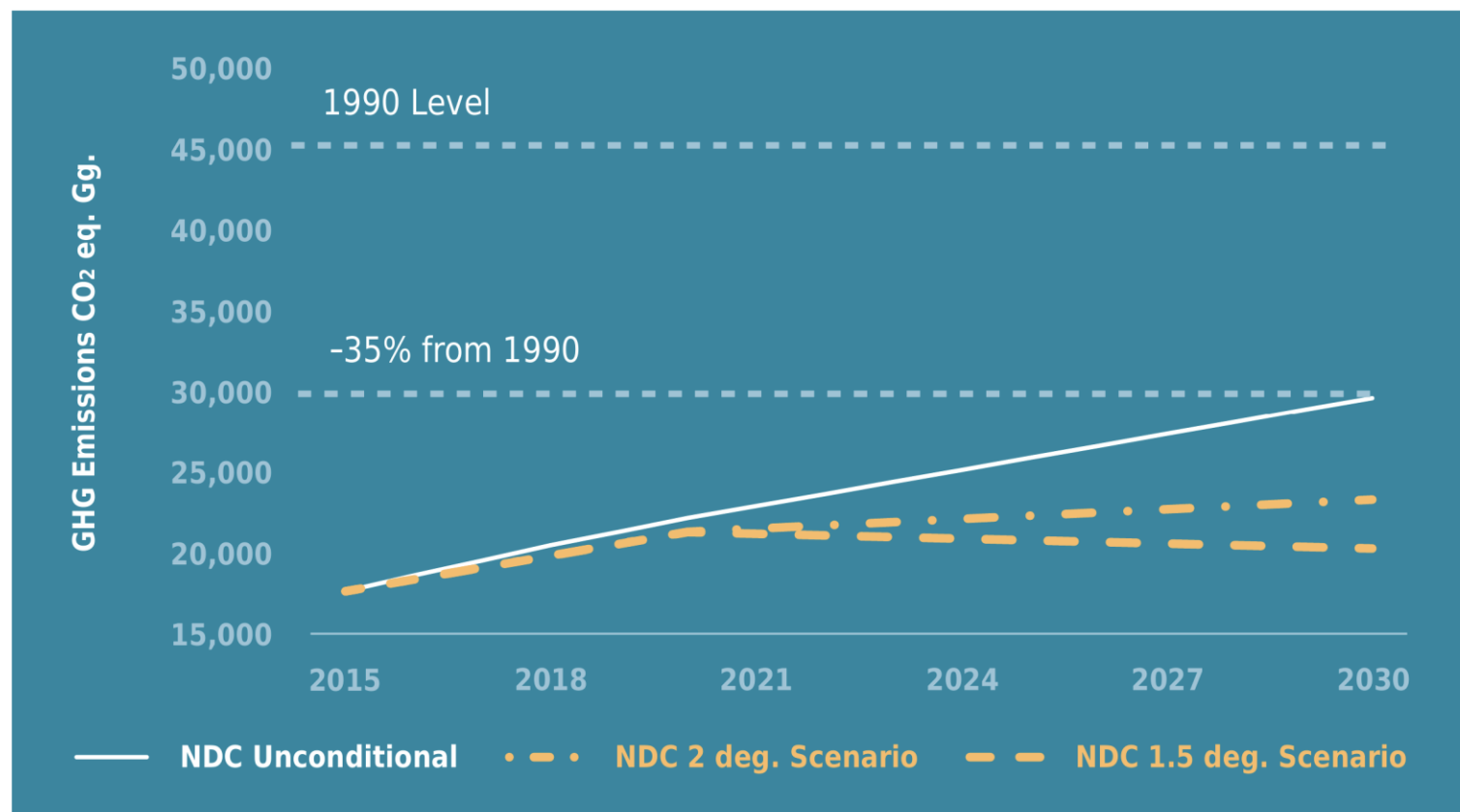
By sector



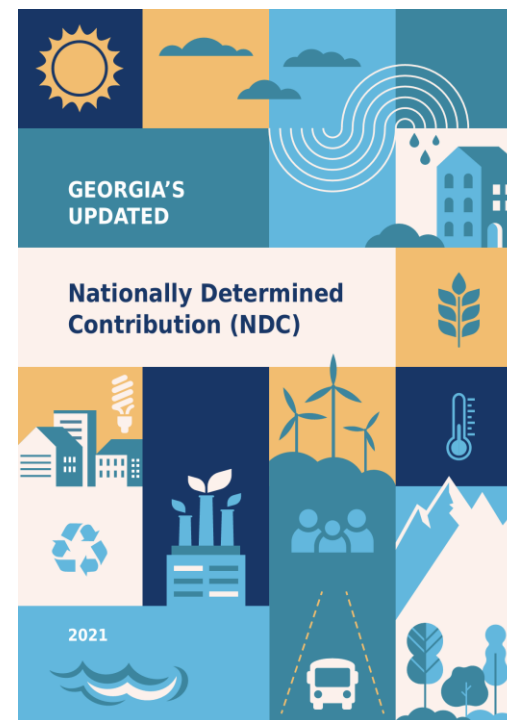
