# THE CONSTITUTION OF

## HAZRAS CHARITY FOUNDATION

#### PREAMBLE

We, the members of HAZRAS CHARITY FOUNDATION a not for-profit and non-political organisation do firmly and solemnly resolve to provide for ourselves a constitution and to be governed by the provisions therein contained.

#### **ARTICLE 1: NAME**

The name of the Association is HAZRAS CHARITY FOUNDATION

#### **ARTICLE 2: ADDRESS**

The address of the Association shall be: NO. 2, AMINU KANO ROAD, GORON DUTSE, GWALE LGA, KANO, NIGERIA

#### **ARTICLE 3: AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

SN	THE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSOCIATION ARE:
1	TO EMPOWER THE LESS PRIVILEGE AND TO RENDER CHARITY AND HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE, AND TO COLLABORATE WITH OTHER NGOS, GOVERNMENT AND STAKEHOLDERS
2	TO ESTABLISH CLINIC HOSPITAL, RURAL ROAD, PORTABLE WATER TO RURAL AREAS IN ORDER TO REDUCE RURAL URBAN MIGRATION
3	TO EDUCATE YOUTH, WOMEN AND LESS PRIVILEGE PEOPLE ON ISLAMIC / WESTERN EDUCATION, AND TO ENGAGE YOUTH ON SELF RELIANCE AND HELP IN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, AND TO ESTERBLISH SCHOOL FOR THE NEEDY AND ORPHANS

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#### **ARTICLE 4: TRUSTEES**

- A. The Trustees of HAZRAS CHARITY FOUNDATION for the purpose of the Companies and Allied Matters Act CAP C20 LFN 2004, shall be elected at a General Meeting charged with responsibility of selecting the Trustees with 2/3 majority votes of members present.
- B. Such Trustees (Hereinafter referred to as, "The Trustees") shall not be less than 2 and more than 15 in number.
- C. A Trustee may hold office for 5 years but shall cease to hold office if he:
  - 1. Resigns his office
  - 2. Ceases to be a member of the registered Trustees of the body.
  - 3. Becomes insane
  - 4. Is officially declared bankrupt
  - 5. Is convicted of a criminal offence involving dishonesty by a Court of competent jurisdiction
  - Is recommended for removal from office by a board of Governors and Trustees majority vote of members present at any General Meeting of the body
  - 7. Ceases to reside in Nigeria
- D. Upon a vacancy occurring in the number of Trustees a General Meeting will be held to appoint another eligible member of the Association.

#### **ARTICLE 5: COMMON SEAL**

- A. The Trustees shall have a Common seal.
- B. Such seal will be kept in the custody of the SECRETARY who shall produce it when required for use by the Trustees.
- C. All documents to be executed by the Trustees shall be signed by such number of them and sealed with the Common seal.

#### **ARTICLE 6: MEETINGS**

For effective administration of the Association, there shall be the following meetings

#### **ARTICLE 7: GOVERNING BODY**

THE ASSOCIATION SHALL HAVE A GOVERNING BODY MADE UP OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICIALS: • THE CHAIRMAN • THE SECRETARY • THE TREASURER • THE PUBLIC RELATIONS OFFICER POWERS, FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE EXECUTIVE OFFICERS. CHAIRMAN - BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGEMENT OF THE ASSOCIATION. - PRESIDE OVERALL MEETINGS OF THE ASSOCIATION. - AUTHORIZE PAYMENTS OF ALL APPROVED EXPENDITURE OF THE ASSOCIATION. -PRESENT AN ADDRESS AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS. - MAY ASSIGN DUTIES TO ANY MEMBER OF THE ASSOCIATION. SECRETARY -SUPERVISE THE RUNNING OF THE ASSOCIATION'S SECRETARIAT -PREPARE ALL MEETINGS AS DIRECTED BY THE CHAIRMAN - ARRANGE ALL PROGRAMMES AS DIRECTED BY THE CHAIRMAN - BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL CORRESPONDENCES TO AND FROM OF THE ASSOCIATION. TREASURER - RECEIVE ALL ASSOCIATION MONIES AND LODGE SAME IN AN ACCOUNT OPENED IN THE NAME OF ASSOCIATION - KEEP ALL THE RECORDS OF THE INCOME AND EXPENDITURE OF THE ASSOCIATION. - BE SIGNATORY TO THE ACCOUNT OF THE ASSOCIATION. - ASSIST THE AUDITOR IN THE DISCHARGE OF HIS ASSIGNMENT. PUBLIC RELATION OFFICER - BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CORPORATE MATTERS SUCH AS PRESS, PROTOCOL, WELFARE AND PROJECTING A GOOD IMAGE FOR THE ASSOCIATION. - BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENTS. - BE IN CONTACT WITH VARIOUS BRANCHES OF THE MEDIA. - CHAIR THE MEDIA COMMITTEE OF THE ASSOCIATION. THEY SHALL ENSURE DAY TO DAY RUNNING OF THE AFFAIRS OF THE ASSOCIATION.

#### **ARTICLE 8: SOURCES OF INCOME**

The sources of income for the Association shall include:

1. MEMBERSHIP DUES, DONATION, AIDS AND VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

#### ARTICLE 9: DISBURSEMENT AND APPLICATION OF FUNDS

THE ASSOCIATION SHALL PROCURE ITS FUNDS FOR ITS DAY TO DAY RUNNING THROUGH THE FOLLOWING MEANS: MEMBERSHIP DUES DONATION AIDS AND VOLUNTARY

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CONTRIBUTIONS WHICH WILL BE DISPERSED FOR THE ATTAINMENT FOR THE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSOCIATION.

#### ARTICLE 10: KEEPING ACCOUNT

THE ORGANIZATION SHALL MAINTAIN A BANK ACCOUNT, AND AUDITORS SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION AT GENERAL MEETING ANNUALLY, AND SUMMIT AN AUDITED REPORT TO ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF ASSOCIATION. THE ASSOCIATION SHALL ENSURE THE ACCURATE KEEPING OF RECORD OF ALL INCOME AND EXPENDITURE. ARTICLE 11: APPOINTMENT.

#### **ARTICLE 11: APPOINTMENT OF AUDITOR(S)**

- 1. Independent qualified and licenced Auditors shall be appointed by the general meeting to audit the financial records of the Association annually and submit an audited report to the Annual General Meeting of the Association.
- 2. The audited financial statements (balance sheet and income and expenditure account) duly certified by independent auditors shall be annexed to the annual returns and file with the Corporate Affairs Commission.

#### **ARTICLE 12: AMENDMENT OF CONSTITUTION**

The Association may alter the provision of its Constitution at a General meeting by a resolution passed by a simple majority of its members and approved by the Commission.

#### ARTIČLE 13: ŠPEČIAL ČLAUŠE

- THE INCOME AND PROPERTY OF HAZRAS CHARITY FOUNDATION shall be applied towards
  the promotion of the objective of the body as set forth in this RULES
  ANDREGULATION/CONSTITUTION: and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly
  orindirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit, to the members of the
  Association.
- 2. PROVIDED that nothing herein shall prevent the payment in good faith, or reasonable and properremuneration to any officer or servant of the Association in return for any service actually rendered to the Association:
  - a. With the exception of ex-officio members of the Governing Council, no member of the Council of Management or Governing Body shall be appointed to any salaried office of the Association or any office of the Association paid by fees; and
  - b. No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the body to any member of such Council or Governing Body except repayment of out of pocket expenses or reasonable and proper rent for premises demised, or let to the Association or reasonable fees for services rendered.
- 3. If in the event of a liquidation/winding-up or dissolution of the corporate body there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or

distributed among the members of the Association but shall be given or transferred to some other institutions, having objects similar to the object of Association, such institutions to be determined by the members of the Association at or before the time of dissolution.

 If effect cannot be given to the aforesaid provisions, then the remaining property shall be transferred to some charitable object.
