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MESSAGE TO CONSTITUENCIES OF ADMITTED NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

Third High-level Ministerial Dialogue on Climate Finance regarding information to be provided by Parties in accordance with Article 9, paragraph 5, of the Paris Agreement

15 November 2025

Belém, Brazil

On behalf of the incoming COP 30, CMP 20 and CMA 7 Presidency, I am pleased to inform constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the **third biennial high-level ministerial dialogue on climate finance regarding information to be provided by Parties in accordance with Article 9, paragraph 5, of the Paris Agreement** will take place on **Saturday, 15 November 2025 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (GMT – 3)**.

The third HLMD will focus on showcasing short- and medium-term solutions for enhancing the predictability and delivery of financial support to developing countries and that contribute to advancing the implementation of Article 9.1 and 9.3 of the Paris Agreement and the qualitative and quantitative elements of the new collective quantified goal on climate finance (NCQG) set at COP 29. Furthermore, the HLMD aims to provide space for Parties and stakeholders to showcase solutions for scaling up adaptation finance to support the urgent and evolving need to accelerate adaptation and build resilience in developing countries. The incoming COP 30 Presidency encourages participants, who are willing to do so, to announce actionable solutions and initiatives, including financial pledges, that contribute to the provision and mobilization of climate finance at scale, including for scaling up adaptation finance.

CMA 1 decided to convene high-level ministerial dialogues on climate finance beginning in 2021, in the context of identification of the information to be provided by Parties in accordance with Article 9, paragraph 5, of the Paris Agreement, to be informed, inter alia, by the biennial communications of indicative quantitative and qualitative information related to Article 9, paragraphs 1 and 3, of the Paris Agreement, as applicable, including, as available, projected levels of public financial resources to be provided to developing country Parties and the summary reports on the biennial in-session workshops beginning the year after the submission of the first biennial communications. The COP 30 President will prepare a summary of the deliberations at the third high-level ministerial dialogue for consideration by CMA 9.

Distribution: To constituency focal points of non-governmental organizations admitted as observers by the Conference of the Parties.

The dialogue will have a webcast. Representatives of admitted NGOs must be nominated by constituency focal points. Kindly note that, owing to the limited capacity of the venue, **two representatives**



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per constituency at the head of organization level, will be permitted to participate in person. Constituency focal points are requested to submit their nominations via cool@unfccc.int no later than **Monday, 10 November 2025**.

The aim of the COP 30 Presidency is to facilitate interactive discussions whereby all participants can take the floor more than once and react to other interventions. In this regard, participants will be requested to make succinct and focused interventions. Interventions will be invited first from Parties, followed by constituencies of admitted NGOs and observers, time permitting. Constituencies of admitted NGOs will be invited to share their full statements in writing for publication on the web page of the dialogue.
