Reporting from Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention Revision of the modalities and guidelines for international consultation and analysis

The Subsidiary Body for Implementation, at its fifty-sixth session, considered the revision of the modalities and guidelines for international consultation and analysis, and recommended the following draft decision for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-seventh session:

Revision of the modalities and guidelines for international consultation and analysis

The Conference of the Parties,

Recalling decisions 1/CP.16, 2/CP.17, 1/CP.24 and 18/CMA.1,

Recognizing that the process of international consultation and analysis is functioning well and has contributed to the enhanced transparency of developing country Parties' reporting on mitigation actions,

1. *Decides* that the modalities and guidelines for international consultation and analysis, contained in annex IV to decision 2/CP.17, shall continue to be used for conducting the technical analysis and facilitative sharing of views for Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention until they are replaced by the modalities, procedures and guidelines contained in the annex to decision 18/CMA.1 for Parties to the Paris Agreement;
 2. *Requests* the Subsidiary Body for Implementation to consider undertaking the review, as appropriate, of the modalities and guidelines for international consultation and analysis, at the latest in the first sessional period of 2028, on the basis of experience in reporting, technical analysis and facilitative sharing of views.
