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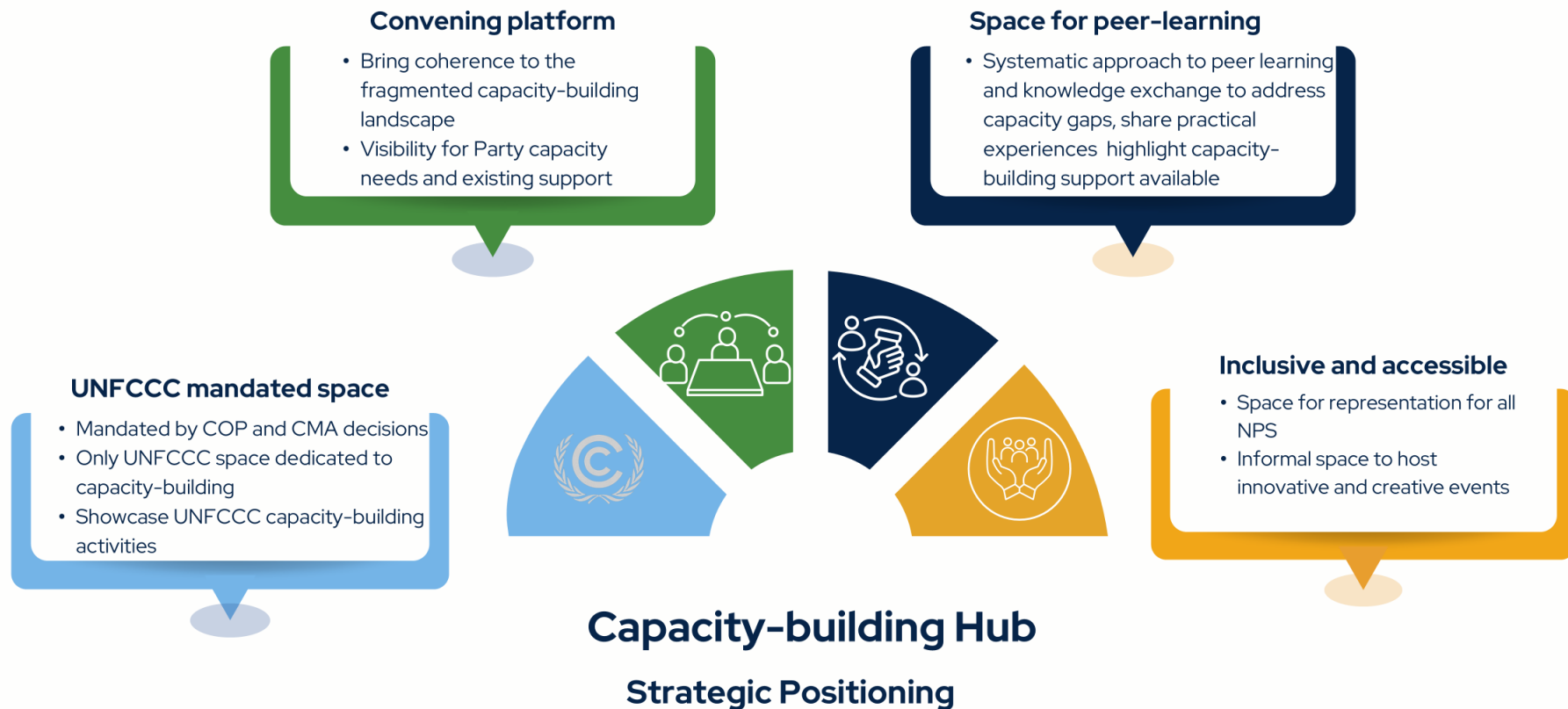

Background

- Established at COP 25
- Mandated by COP 30 to organise the 8th Capacity-building Hub
- Activity under the PCCB's 2025-2029 workplan
(Priority area C: promoting awareness-raising, knowledge- and information-sharing and stakeholder engagement with bodies and relevant actors under and outside the Convention and the Paris Agreement)



Objectives of the Capacity-building Hub

Strengthen the capacity of developing countries to prepare, update, and implement their NDCs and NAPs, with a focus on practical implementation challenges and opportunities.

Enhance the reach and visibility of capacity-building activities undertaken by the secretariat, ICG members, PCCB Network and other capacity-building programmes

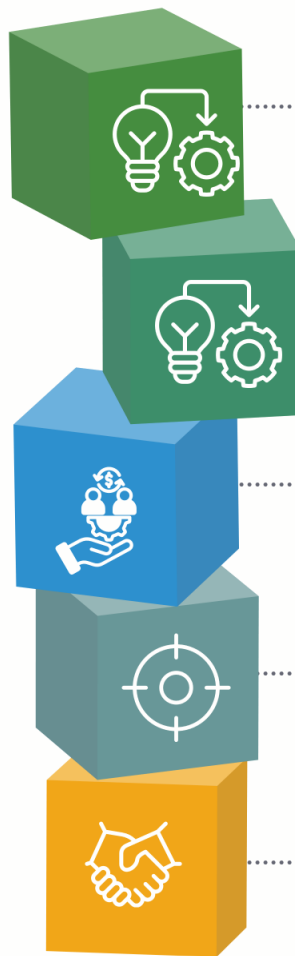
Utilize the insights and outcomes generated to inform and support the PCCB's workstreams, including the State of Capacity building report, knowledge products, and related outputs.

Deliver targeted and policy-relevant sessions for specific stakeholder groups

Provide technically grounded, hands-on capacity building sessions for specific stakeholder groups

Overarching Themes

Cross-cutting – stakeholders, mainstreaming gender, Indigenous People and local communities, and youth capacity-building are considered in the context of the themes



Mitigation

Capacity-building to implement NDCs, and to support energy, industry and transport transitions

Adaptation

Capacity-building to implement NAPs, and to support stewarding forests, oceans and biodiversity; transform agriculture and food systems; building resilience for cities, infrastructure and water

Finance, technology and capacity-building (MoI)

Capacity-building to support access to climate finance; address technology-related needs
