- 2. Asia-Pacific Climate Week (APCW), 2–6 September, Shenzhen, Guangdong, China, organized by UNFCCC
- 3. Second Annual Meeting of the Malaga Coalition on municipal investment finance, Malaga, Spain on 3–4 October 2019
- 4. International Renewable Energy Conference (IREC), 22–25 October, 2019 in Seoul, organized by REN21
- 5. C40 Summit, which is taking place in Copenhagen from 9–10 October
- 6. 7th Asian Pacific Urban Forum, 15–17 October, Penang, Malaysia (www.unescap.org/events/apuf7)

Political messages and outcomes of discussions

- 1. Crucial role local governments play in reaching the goals of the Paris Agreement and close the finance gap + link with SDGs
- 2. Importance of advocating for vertical integration for NDC implementation and financing
- 3. Importance of supporting (already early stage) project preparation and capacity building with local and regional governments
- 4. Urge to have a coherent definition on subnational climate finance, as well as to track subnational climate finance flows
- 5. Urge direct city access to UN climate funds provided by its operating entities (GCF, GEF) and the Adaptation Fund to support project implementation, preparation and readiness of urban investments.
- 6. Support the creation of local financial intermediaries to develop adapted financial solutions and to localize funding and financing
- 7. Stop separation of adaptation and mitigation in providing funding for financing streams
- 8. Harmonization of existing infrastructure standards
- 9. The need for new development finance solutions that directly support city low carbon/climate resilience ambitions and accelerated implementation of city climate action plans
