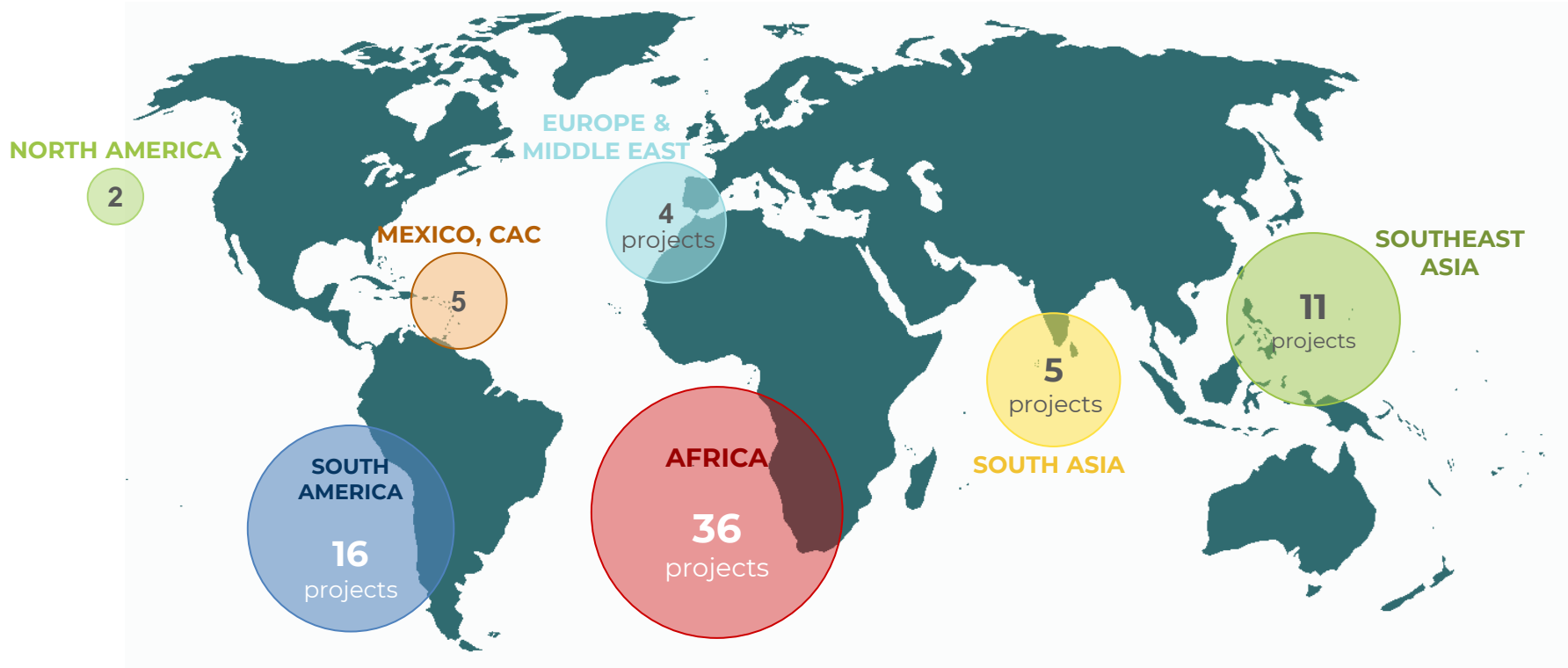

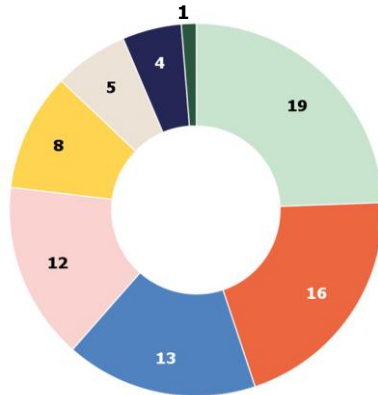

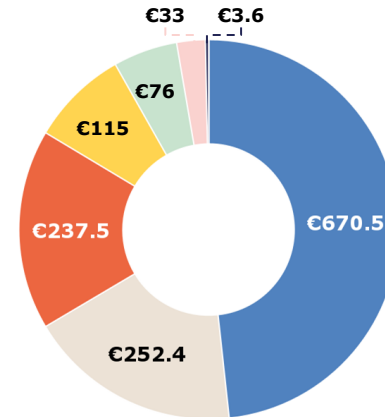

Mérida, México

Financing Sustainable Mobility as a Road to Urban Integration



- Enhance internal interconnectedness through transport infrastructure and drainage systems
- Promotion of active mobility and interconnectedness
- Participatory approach for ensuring sustainability



Primary sectors: mobility



Support Provided: Technical Assistance



Partnered with the World Resource Institute (WRI) through the CityFixLabs initiative.



Example:

Makindye, Uganda

Analysing waste management alternatives



- Tackle indiscriminate disposal of waste and lack of clean energy sources
- Circular model through PPP: adequate waste disposal and use solid waste as energy source
- Use of solid waste as briquettes to use as compost, and production of biogas



Primary sectors: energy & waste



Support provided: technical assistance



Accessed Gap Fund for technical assistance and currently in the **Gap Fund Step-Up** project



Example:

Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia

Thermo-technical rehabilitation of precast panel buildings in Ulaanbaatar City



- Develop large-scale thermo-technical retrofitting program
- Establish market conditions to scale up investment in energy efficiency



Primary sectors: infrastructure retrofitting



Support provided: technical assistance & financing



Results: 14,068 households improved thermal comfort and air quality; mitigating 2.4 MtCO₂e



Example:

Brasília, Brazil

Analysing waste management alternatives



- Involvement of government actors, universities, 25 civil society organizations,
- Participatory ecosystem mapping and restoration project and nature-based restoration initiatives.



Primary sectors: water & housing



Support provided: technical assistance



Impacts: ecosystems mapped and restored, creation of protected areas, and building of cross-sectoral governance networks
