

SUBMISSION BY THE G77+CHINA ON APPROACH AND POSSIBLE ELEMENTS FOR THE FIFTH REVIEW OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FRAMEWORK FOR CAPACITY-BUILDING IN COUNTRIES WITH ECONOMIES IN TRANSITION

- Acknowledging that the scope of the needs identified in the framework for capacity building in countries with economies in transition established under decision 3/CP.7 continue to be the basis for, and guide the implementation of, capacity-building activities in countries with economies in transition;
- Emphasising that the submissions made by Regional Grouping and Parties shall will be used by the co-facilitators as input into drafting of the elements and that these elements will be subjected to further discussion during the informal consultations; and
- That the co-facilitators should consider the Decision 17/CP.23 as a basis for the fifth review of the implementation of the framework for capacity-building in countries with economies in transition (to follow the same format when drafting the elements and possible outcome at COP26).
- This Review takes place under the framework of the Convention and the Kyoto Protocol, and not in the context of the Paris Agreement where economies in transition are not signalled as a differentiated group of countries.
- As such, this review should keep to its mandate and frameworks not be extended to the Paris Agreement.
- Furthermore, any changes to eligibility in the Green Climate Fund (GCF) requires adjustments to the Governing Instrument of the GCF that is not up to negotiation.
