

Update from the IPCC Task Force on National Greenhouse Gas inventories (TFI)

The IPCC TFI will produce the following two Methodology Reports in the AR7 cycle:

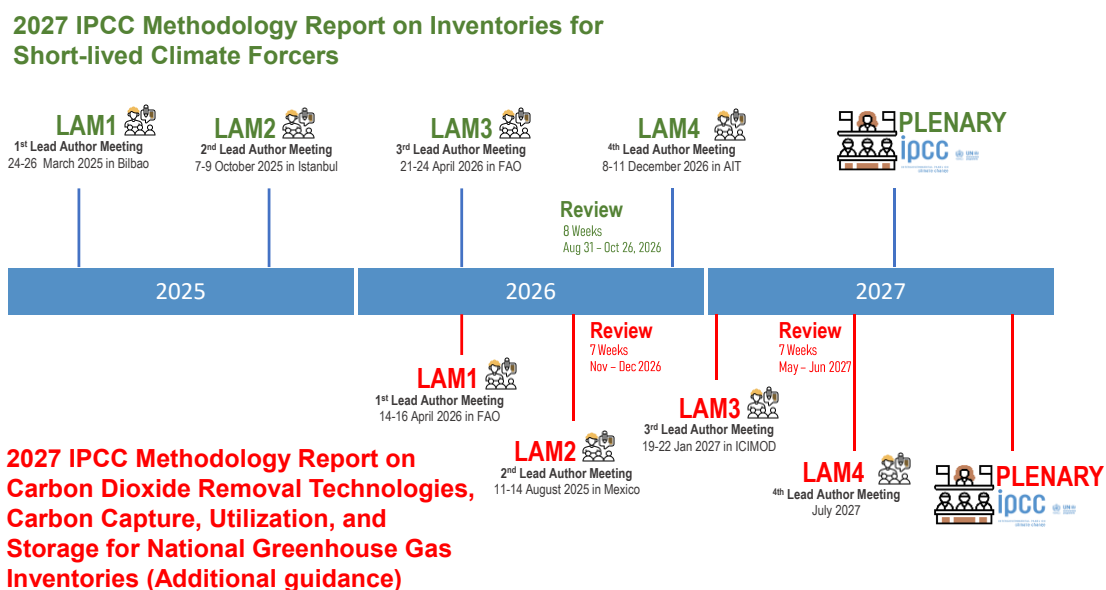
- *2027 IPCC Methodology Report on Inventories for Short-lived Climate Forcers*
- *2027 IPCC Methodology Report on Carbon Dioxide Removal Technologies, Carbon Capture, Utilization, and Storage for National Greenhouse Gas Inventories (Additional guidance)*

Work on the SLCF Methodology Report began in early 2025, and the authors produced the First Order Draft (FOD) at the end of 2025. The expert review of the FOD has been completed, and the authors are currently addressing review comments in the preparation of the Second Order Draft (SOD). The SOD will undergo a second review (by Governments and Experts) from late August to October 2026. All registered experts will have the opportunity to comment on the SOD.

The CDR/CCUS Methodology Report held its first Lead Author Meeting (LAM) in April 2026, and drafting of the FOD is underway. The FOD is expected to be completed by October 2026, after which registered experts will have the opportunity to comment during the first review period from November to December 2026. The authors will prepare the SOD by May 2027, at which time experts will again have the opportunity to review the draft.

All inventory experts are invited to register via the IPCC website (<https://www.ipcc.ch/>). Information on registration will be provided closer to each review period. We look forward to the participation of UNFCCC inventory reviewers in the Methodology Report development process.
