SPOTLIGHT OUR ENTERPRISES

Plotlokolo Business Investments (Pty) Ltd is a recycling enterprise that collects used cooking oil from local fast food shops and supermarkets to produce a green multi purpose bar soap. The multi purpose soap is sold to households, to food outlets, and to supermarkets such as Makro (online). Recently the company has entered into joint venture partnership with the German company Biotensidon to scale their business.

SOCIAL IMPACT

- 300 food stores were approached for awareness and education on used cooking oil.
- 56 businesses are providing used cooking oil for the production of soap.
