On behalf of the Government of Costa Rica, the secretariat would like to share information regarding the organization, logistics and visa requirements related to the Preparatory Meeting of the Twenty-Fifth Conference of the Parties of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, Pre-COP 25, to be held from 8 to 10 October 2019, in San José, Costa Rica.

Participants requiring a visa are advised that the Government of Costa Rica will assist in obtaining a visa upon arrival. • A legible photocopy of the front page of the passport (please indicate if it is an Ordinary, Official or Diplomatic passport). Passports must have a six-month validity.

The secretariat would like to point out that a yellow fever international vaccine certificate will be requested upon arrival in Costa Rica.
