INFORMATION NOTE TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AND NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

Opening of the Online Registration System United Nations Climate Change Conference, SB 64 8 – 18 June 2026 Bonn, Germany

The secretariat refers to the forthcoming sixty-fourth sessions of the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SB 64) to be held from 8 – 18 June 2026 at the [World Conference Center Bonn](#) (WCCB) Bonn, Germany and wishes to inform all intergovernmental organizations (IGOs) and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) admitted as observers by the Conference of the Parties that the online registration system (available at <https://onlinereg.unfccc.int/>), which allows observer organizations to nominate representatives to attend sessions, is now open for registration for SB 64, and will remain open for nomination of participants representing IGOs and NGOs until **Monday, 16 March 2026, 23:59, Central European Time (CET)**.

The ORS will be open for the **confirmation** by IGOs and NGOs of their representatives from **Monday, 30 March 2026 until Sunday, 7 June 2026, 23:59 Central European Summer Time (CEST)**. Nomination and confirmation deadlines will be applied strictly, as the secretariat is not able to process late nominations or confirmations.

The manual on how to access and use the system is available [here](#). ORS is the only official channel for nominating participants for SB 64. The secretariat is not in a position to process nominations submitted by any other method.

Please note that **it is imperative that a correct and unique email address be provided for each delegate** for swift processing of registration confirmations. Once the delegate is confirmed in the ORS, an email with a link to download the acknowledgment letter will be sent to the email address of the confirmed delegate.

In accordance with decision 23/CP.18, and with a view to promoting gender balance and improving the participation of women in UNFCCC negotiations, the nomination of women delegates to attend the conference is kindly encouraged. Additionally, in accordance with decisions 1/CP.26 and 1/CMA.3, and with a view to promoting youth participation in relevant climate processes at the national and international level, the nomination of youth delegates is also kindly encouraged.
