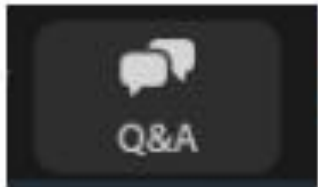

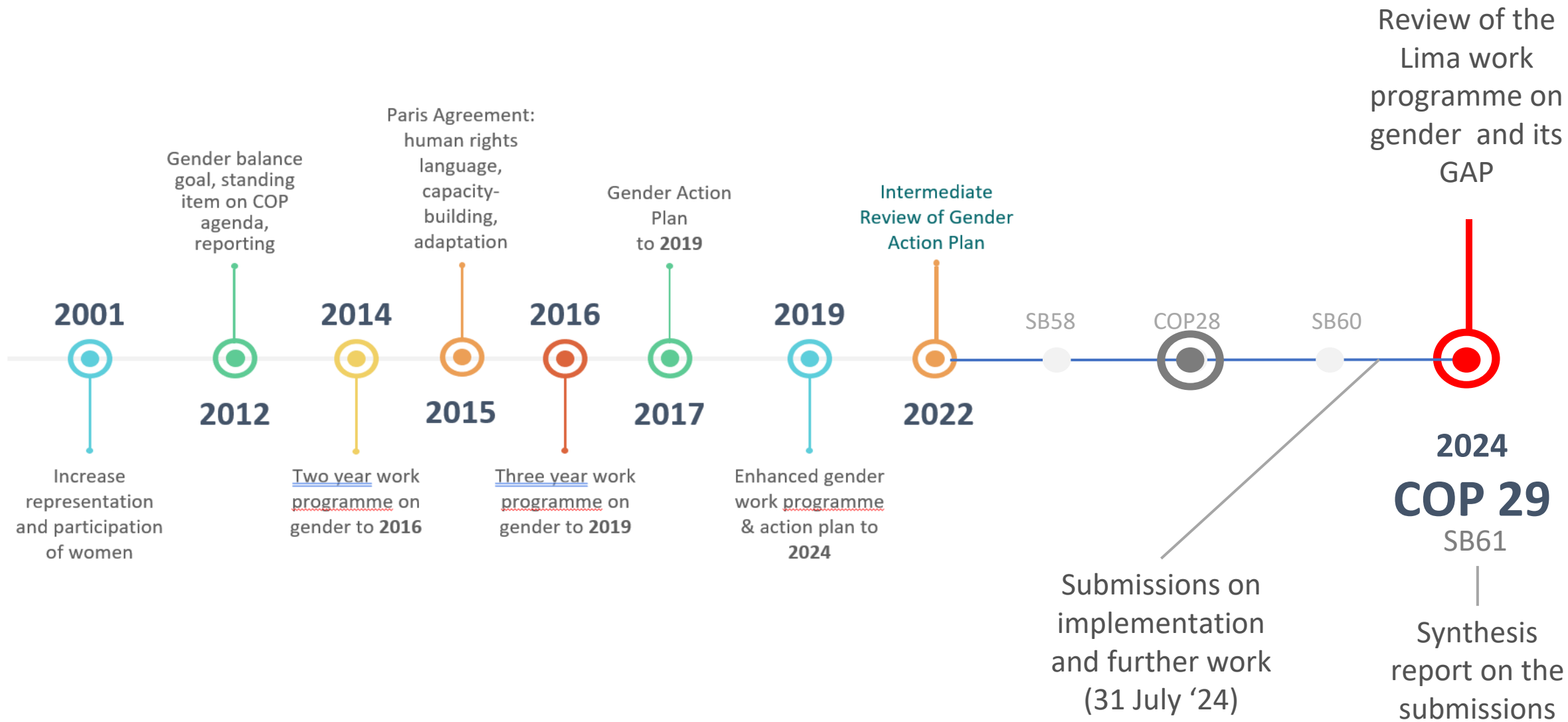

Standing Committee on Finance: Mandate and Functions

- The Standing Committee on Finance (SCF) was established at COP16 to assist the COP with respect to the Financial Mechanism and undertakes technical work on climate finance in line with its mandated functions, namely:



Improving coherence and coordination in delivery of climate finance



Rationalization of the Financial Mechanism



Mobilization of financial resources



MRV of support to developing country Parties



- The SCF conducts various activities to fulfill these functions and develops technical findings and recommendations for the COP, to help Parties make informed decisions relating to climate finance in the UNFCCC process.

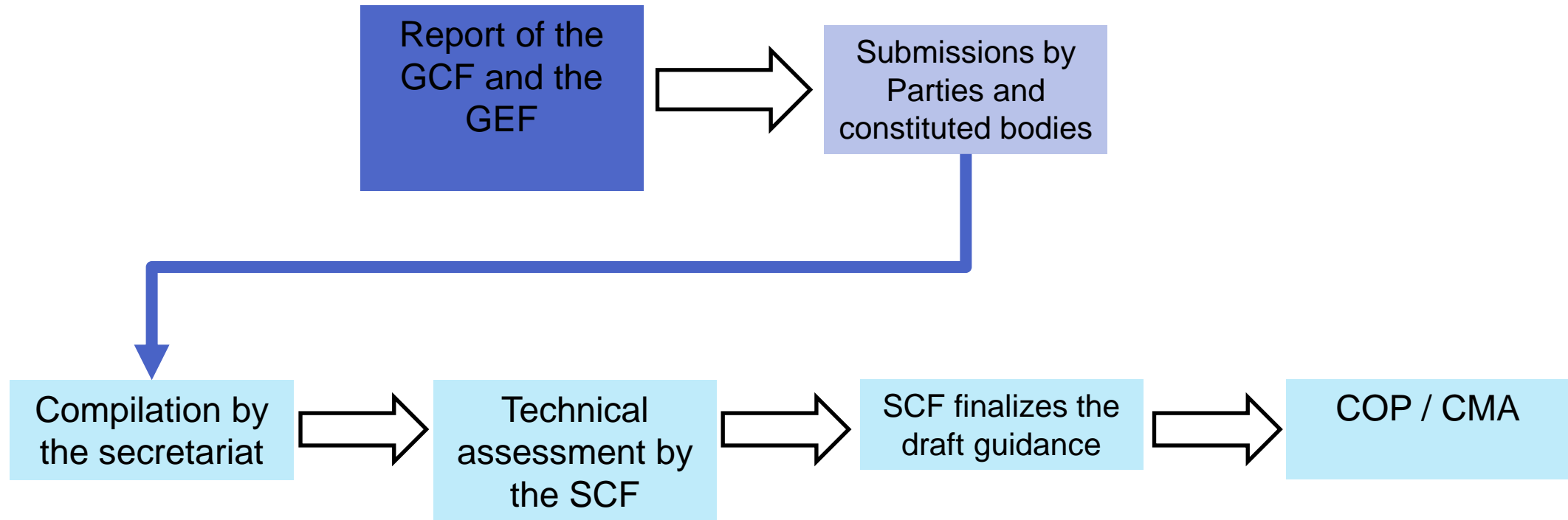

About the WGC

Official Constituency under the UNFCCC

Supports the coordination, engagement and collective advocacy of women's rights organizations and gender experts into the process.

- **2009:** Founded as an Observer constituency to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) with around seven initiating orgs & granted full Observer Constituency status in 2011;
- **2015:** Launched the Gender Just Climate Solutions Awards Program;
- **2023:** 47 member organisations (with official accreditation to UNFCCC) plus hosted advocacy network of over 700 groups/organisations/individuals;
- **2023:** Building out work to regionalize the work of the WGC, including support the formation of the African Feminist Taskforce which led our advocacy and demands for COP27.
