Workshop under the UAE-Belém work programme on indicators

8–9 October 2024, Sharm el-Sheikh, Egypt

I am pleased to invite constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations to participate in the mandated technical workshop under the UAE–Belém work programme on indicators. The workshop is being organized pursuant to the SB 60 conclusions on matters relating to the global goal on adaptation in which the Subsidiary Bodies requested their Chairs, with the support of the secretariat, to organize a hybrid workshop under the work programme prior to CMA 6.

The workshop is scheduled to take place from 8 to 9 October 2024 in a hybrid format, with the inperson element taking place in Sharm el-Sheikh, Egypt. The workshop will be hosted by the Government of Egypt and organized by the UNFCCC, as part of a <u>series of four mandated events</u>.

Given space limitations, participation of admitted NGOs will be limited to representatives nominated by NGO Constituency Focal Points (CFPs). Nominated representatives must register for the dialogue using the online registration form, which will be communicated to the nominated participants. Kindly note that, owing to the limited capacity of the venue, only one representative per constituency will be permitted to participate in person. CFPs are requested to submit their nominations to cool@unfccc.int no later than Wednesday, 21 August 2024.

Additional observers may participate virtually. The deadline for registration for virtual participation through the CFPs is **Wednesday**, **21 August 2024**. For those who wish to follow the workshop without active participation, it will also be broadcast live on YouTube.

In view of the need to confirm arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, registrations received after the above-mentioned deadlines may not be processed.

Please note that in-person participants are responsible for making their own travel arrangements, including regarding visas and medical insurance, as well as for checking entry information and travel regulations for Egypt.

Further details relevant to in-person and virtual participation in both events will be communicated directly to the registered participants.
