Workshop to advance the engagement of the private sector in adaptation

Bonn, Germany, 24 to 26 October 2018



I: Introduction and background

- The AC agreed to advance activities on the engagement of the private sector
- ❖ As agreed at AC11, a mapping of actors was undertaken, entailing preparation of a review of relevant literature, together with an open survey of private sector adaptation action and motivations
- Reports on these activities, as well as an overview report presenting key findings as well as possible next steps were considered at AC12
- ❖ As a follow-up to this work, the AC agreed to convene a workshop in 2018 and agreed on the scope and guiding questions, the flow and format of the sessions and potential partner organizations at AC13



II: Scope and programme

- ❖ Based on the outcomes of AC13, the title of the workshop is "Fostering the engagement of the agri-food sector in resilience to climate change";
- The workshop will take place on 29-31 October in Geneva, Switzerland and will be hosted by the International Trade Centre (ITC);
- Three main topics:
 - 1. Assessing climate risks for enterprises in the agri-food sector and designing adaptation strategies;
 - 2. Implementing climate change adaptation strategies;
 - 3. Designing policies to scale up private sector adaptation action.



III: Programme

- Organizations were asked to contribute to the workshop through a call for contribution;
- This resulted in the organization of 15 workshop and open lab sessions by 24 partner organizations;
- ❖ In terms of participation, 96 participants were registered as of 19 October
- ❖ Participation is balanced in terms of developed and developing country experts as well as gender and type of organization.



III: Outreach and follow-up

- Outreach via the International Trade Centre's social media channels and supported through the UNFCCC secretariat's channels;
- Comprehensive news article to be distributed after the meeting;
- Building up a network of private sector contacts;
- Draft report prior to COP24.
