Ms. Junko Ota is a policy researcher of Institute for Global Environment Strategies (IGES), a public think tank of Japanese government. Stationed in a satellite in Kitakyushu City, her specialization includes city-to-city collaboration among cities in Japan and developing countries for low-carbon society as well as localization of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), acting as the Vice-Chair of the SDGs Council of Kitakyushu City.

She has been engaged in UNFCCC meetings mainly on finance topics as a Japanese delegation since 2006, once stationed in Japanese Embassy in Germany as a liaison to UNFCCC. She also worked as a JICA's technical assistant in Indonesia for development of the Indonesia's National Action Plan for Adaptation during 2012-2014.

Born in Tokyo, but graduated from the University of Hawaii and graduate school of Rutgers, New Jersey (MA) in US with a thesis on "Kyoto Protocol: Struggle to reconcile equity and efficiency through the involvement of developing countries".
