#### **Highlights of work undertaken in the first half of 2021:**

In the first half of 2021, the KCI implemented two of its work plan activities inter-sessionally by preparing two technical papers in order to consider them at its 4<sup>th</sup> meeting. The KCI held its 4<sup>th</sup> meeting virtually during 25-27 May and 1-4 June 2021.

During its 4<sup>th</sup> meeting, , KCI implemented two of its workplan activities, considered integration of gender in its workplan, prepared strategy for implementing activities in the workplan of the Katowice Committee on Impacts for 2021–2022, considered conflict of interest provision for KCI and attended some procedural matters.

The KCI considered draft technical papers prepared by the open-ended working group for its two mandated activities, viz.,

- Activity 3 “Facilitate the development, enhancement, customization and use of tools and methodologies for modelling and assessing the impacts of the implementation of response measures, including identifying and reviewing existing tools and approaches in data-poor environments, in consultation with technical experts, practitioners and other relevant stakeholders”. Draft technical paper for activity 3 is accompanied with a data base on tools and methods; and
- Activity 4 “Enhance the capacity and understanding of Parties, through collaboration and input from stakeholders, on the assessment and analysis of the impacts of the implementation of response measures to facilitate the undertaking of economic diversification and transformation and just transition”.

The KCI agreed to approaches to integrate gender in KCI's work and nominated its Co-Chairs as gender focal points. KCI will prepare a draft concept note containing a detailed description of the approaches and illustrative examples of how to apply the approaches for consideration at its next meeting.

KCI agreed to a strategy to implement its work plan activities to be delivered during 2021-2022.

KCI adopted its 4<sup>th</sup> meeting report and its annual report 2020-2021 which contains possible recommendations for the forum to consider with a view to making recommendations to the COP, the CMP and the CMA. These recommendations emerged from the implementation of KCI's activity 1 of the workplan, i.e. "Explore approaches to inform the development and implementation of climate change mitigation strategies, plans, policies and programmes that maximize the positive and minimize the negative impacts of response measure".
