Background

At KCI 7, the KCI agreed to include a standing item entitled “**Update on relevant meetings, events and initiatives**” in the agenda for its future meetings.



Response measures decisions (6/CP.30, 2/CMP.20, 14/CMA.7)

- Welcome KCI annual report, adopt recommendations, take note of the timeline and modalities for implementing the 2026-2030 workplan.
- Forum, at each COP session, to decide which activity it will implement in the following year.
 - For 2026: Three activities at SB 64 and four activities at SB 65
- Request the forum and the KCI to implement the 2026-2030 workplan and continue make recommendations to the governing bodies.
- Request KCI to present its annual report and key findings to the forum each year for consideration.
- Decide to hold a two-day global dialogue annually from 2026 to 2029 and request forum to consider further dialogues in SB 71 (Nov 2029)
- Request the KCI and the CGE to collaborate on exploring ways to enhance the capacity of Parties to report in the impacts of the implementation of response measures.
 - Note: Under CMP decision, CMP *invite* the CGE

PCCB annual technical progress report

- **invites** constituted bodies to consider good practices on integration of a gender perspective into their processes and reporting and to include in their annual reports information on how they are improving the content and structure of their reporting in this area
- adopt the Belém gender action plan for 2026–2034 and decide to review at COP 34 (Nov 2029), which constituted bodies are **invited** to make submission for the review by Feb. 2029
- **invites** UNFCCC constituted bodies to enhance implementation of the Belém gender action plan
 - Strengthen the evidence base for differentiated impacts and opportunities on women (Priority area A.3)
 - Strengthen the role of the national gender focal points via workshops and capacity building (Priority area A.2)
 - Inclusion of gender-responsive communication (Priority area A.5)
 - Exchange on how to strengthen the integration of gender perspective among the Chairs of constituted bodies and work programmes (Priority area C.2)



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- **Invites** UNFCCC constituted bodies to integrate just transition elements into existing workplans and report on progress
- *Others:*
 - Decides to develop just transition mechanism
 - Requests SB to develop ToR for the review of the work programme at SB 64



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Under modalities of UAE dialogue:

- **invites** constituted bodies to submit views to the UAE dialogue on implementing the global stocktake outcomes by no later than three months prior to each dialogue
 - UAE dialogue to be held during SB 64 and SB 66

Under procedural elements of GST process:

- **encourages** relevant constituted bodies/forums to streamline information in reports for GST



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- **encourages** constituted bodies to consider recommendations in the PCCB annual technical progress report and take action, as appropriate

- Requests **2026 ACE dialogue** to include representatives of UNFCCC constituted bodies to discuss new action plan

- Requests the secretariat to develop and implement set of activities in collaboration with CGE and other constituted bodies

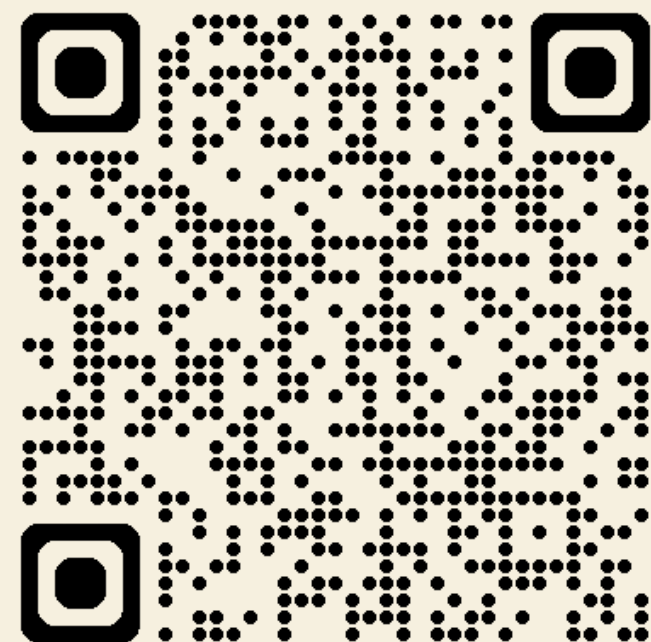
