Kevin Adams is the Lead Climate Finance Negotiator for the United States and Advisor to Special Presidential Envoy for Climate, John Kerry. In this capacity, Kevin supports international climate policy negotiations at the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), the United Nations General Assembly, G7/G20, OECD, and other relevant fora.

Kevin serves as member of the UNFCCC Standing Committee on Finance (SCF), Alternate Board Member of the Adaptation Fund, advisor to the U.S. Board Member of the Green Climate Fund (GCF), and as the U.S. delegate for the OECD Working Party on Climate Investment and Development (WPCID) and Climate Change Expert Group (CCXG).

Kevin is also a PhD Candidate at the Grantham Research Institute for Climate Change and Society (GRI) at the London School of Economics (LSE). His academic research is focused on the intersection of climate change risk, international trade, and regime complexes as sites of political conflict or multilateral cooperation.

Prior to joining the State Department, Kevin worked as a Research Fellow at the Stockholm Environment Institute (SEI). He has presented at a wide variety of international conferences and meetings, published numerous academic journal articles and policy reports, and served as an expert consultant including for the UNFCCC, the GCF, the European Environment Agency, and the Food and Agriculture Organization.
