Klimanjarø – Climate Neutral Supply Chain

Norway

[Fjordkraft](#), the second largest electricity retailer in Norway, is using its purchasing power to inspire all its suppliers to be climate neutral by 2019.

Fjordkraft has been climate neutral since 2007, but decided in June 2016 it could do more, launching its Klimanjarø project to inspire its suppliers to make bold commitments to climate action: to measure greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, reduce what they can, and offset the rest. The name, Klimanjarø combines klima, the Norwegian word for climate, with the name of Africa's highest peak, Mount Kilimanjarø. Mount Kilimanjarø is difficult to climb, but fully feasible if everyone summits together.

Key facts

- 103 of Fjordkraft's 138 service providers and suppliers have signed letters committing to become climate neutral by 2019;
- To date, the commitments from suppliers in total are close to 100-times greater than emissions from Fjordkraft's own operations;
- GHG emissions from more than 24,000 employees will be reduced and offset by 2019.
