Accelerating Gender Equality in Africa's Green Transition Country experiences integrating gender in NDCs 3.0 in West and Central Africa A learning event

Background

In 2025, countries are expected to submit updated versions of their Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs), with a focus on increasing ambition in line with the global goal of limiting warming to 1.5°C. The NDC 3.0 process will likely include more robust strategies for mitigation, adaptation, and resilience-building, with an emphasis on aligning climate action with sustainable development goals.

One of the important features of the NDC 3.0 process is the increased call for inclusivity and ensuring that marginalized groups — such as women, youth, and indigenous populations — are part of the decision-making process. In Africa, in particular, there is growing recognition of the need to integrate gender considerations into climate policies, as gender inequalities impact the vulnerability to climate change.

In the lead-up to the NDC revision process, UN Women has developed a <u>Toolkit</u> to integrate gender in climate policies, which provides national governments in Sub-Saharan Africa with a practical resource to effectively address gender equality issues in the development and implementation of their NDCs. To help accelerate gender equality in climate policies, this webinar will use the toolkit to strengthen participants' capacity to effectively integrate gender considerations into the NDC revision process and other national climate policies such as National Adaptation Plans (NAPs) and Long-Term Low greenhouse gas Emission Development Strategies (<u>LT-LEDS</u>). It will also help identify opportunities to finance gender equality as part of the green transition. As part of this session, governments will also share their experience in developing a gender-responsive NDC 3.0.
