### **About LACCW**

The LACCW is set to boost the region's response to climate change. It is a unique collaborative platform for government and non-Party stakeholders to address the width of climate issues under one umbrella and unity of purpose. This year, the Climate Week is organized in support of a strong outcome at the UN Climate Action Summit hosted by the Secretary-General on 23 September 2019. LACCW 2019 will gather ministers, policymakers and other local, national, regional leaders, representatives of the private sector, investors and civil society to engage in in-depth discussions on four of the nine Summit tracks: energy transition; industry transition; infrastructure, cities and local action; and nature-based solutions. It will also consolidate the region's contribution to Summit to the extent possible.

## **Arrangements for the press**

The Latin America and Caribbean Climate Week 2019 is organized in two parts:

- Technical Days (Monday-Tuesday)
- Thematic Dialogues (Wednesday-Friday)

Please, note that on Monday and Tuesday events are mainly closed and attendance is invitationonly.

On Monday and Tuesday, journalists may attend the open events and side events specified in the agenda.

The official opening of the Thematic Dialogues will be on Wednesday, 21 August and it's open to all participants.

Upon arrival, members of the press will receive an official <u>conference badge</u> and a <u>secondary</u> <u>press badge</u>. For security reasons, all participants are requested to wear their badges visibly at all times.

Communications and public relations officers will not be provided the secondary press badge, only the conference badge.

From Wednesday to Friday, a press room will be available to those participants with a secondary press badge.

Please note that the space in this room is limited and seats cannot be reserved in advance.


Also, note that the LACCW will not be webcast live but journalists can arrange for interviews in the open spaces of the venue and make video and/or audio recordings of the open events.
