Informal dialogue on the development of the dedicated LCIPP web portal

SBSTA 50, June 2019

Introduction

The Conference of the Parties (COP) requested the secretariat to develop activities related to the implementation of all three functions of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform (LCIPP) at each session of the SBSTA until the workplan is adopted.¹

In addition, decision 2/CP.24 also requested the secretariat to make the work of the LCIPP widely accessible, including through the development of a dedicated web portal on the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform on the UNFCCC website. This will be done with the support of the Facilitative Working Group.

Scope

This meeting will be an informal and open space for sharing ideas on the web portal. The discussions will complement ideas that were put forward during the four webinar sessions held in April 2019.

The engagement of diverse stakeholders is integral to the operation of the LCIPP. It will also help facilitate and enhance the development of the web portal, and will make the work of the LCIPP widely accessible. This informal dialogue will be open to all interested stakeholders at the SB 50 session.
