Introduction:

The Conference of the Parties (COP) requested the UNFCCC secretariat to develop activities related to the implementation of all three functions of the Local Communities and Indigenous Peoples Platform (LCIPP) at each session of the SBSTA until the workplan is adopted.¹

The COP also encouraged the FWG to collaborate with other bodies under and outside the Convention, as appropriate, aiming at enhancing the coherence of the actions of the LCIPP under the Convention.²

Scope

The dialogue will create a space for United Nations entities, civil society organizations and other stakeholders to share recent work and mandates relevant to the Platform. The informal dialogue will also allow stakeholders to share potential collaborative opportunities to enhance the engagement of local communities and indigenous peoples in climate change policies and actions that affect their lives.

This informal dialogue will be open to observers.
