

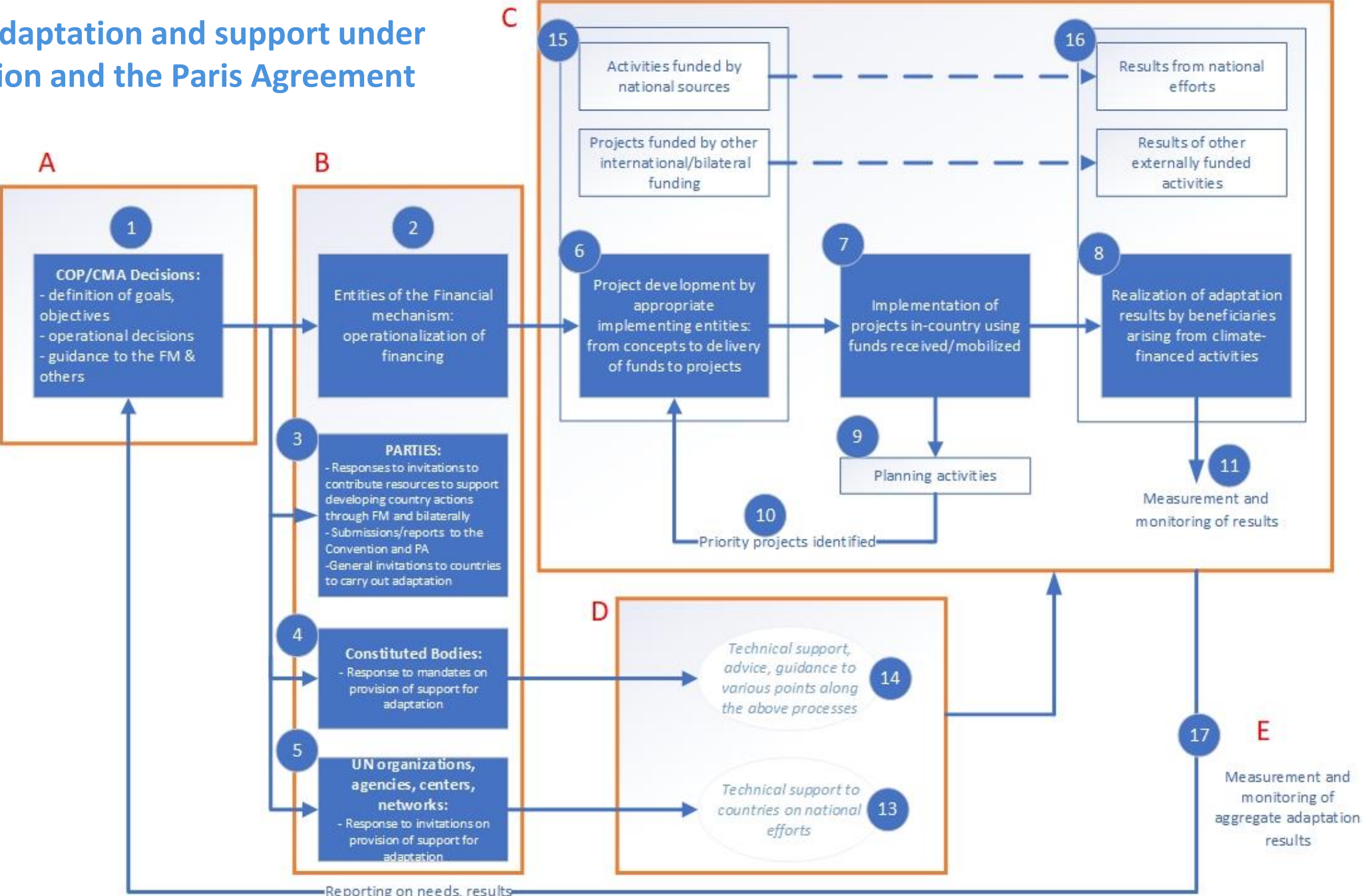

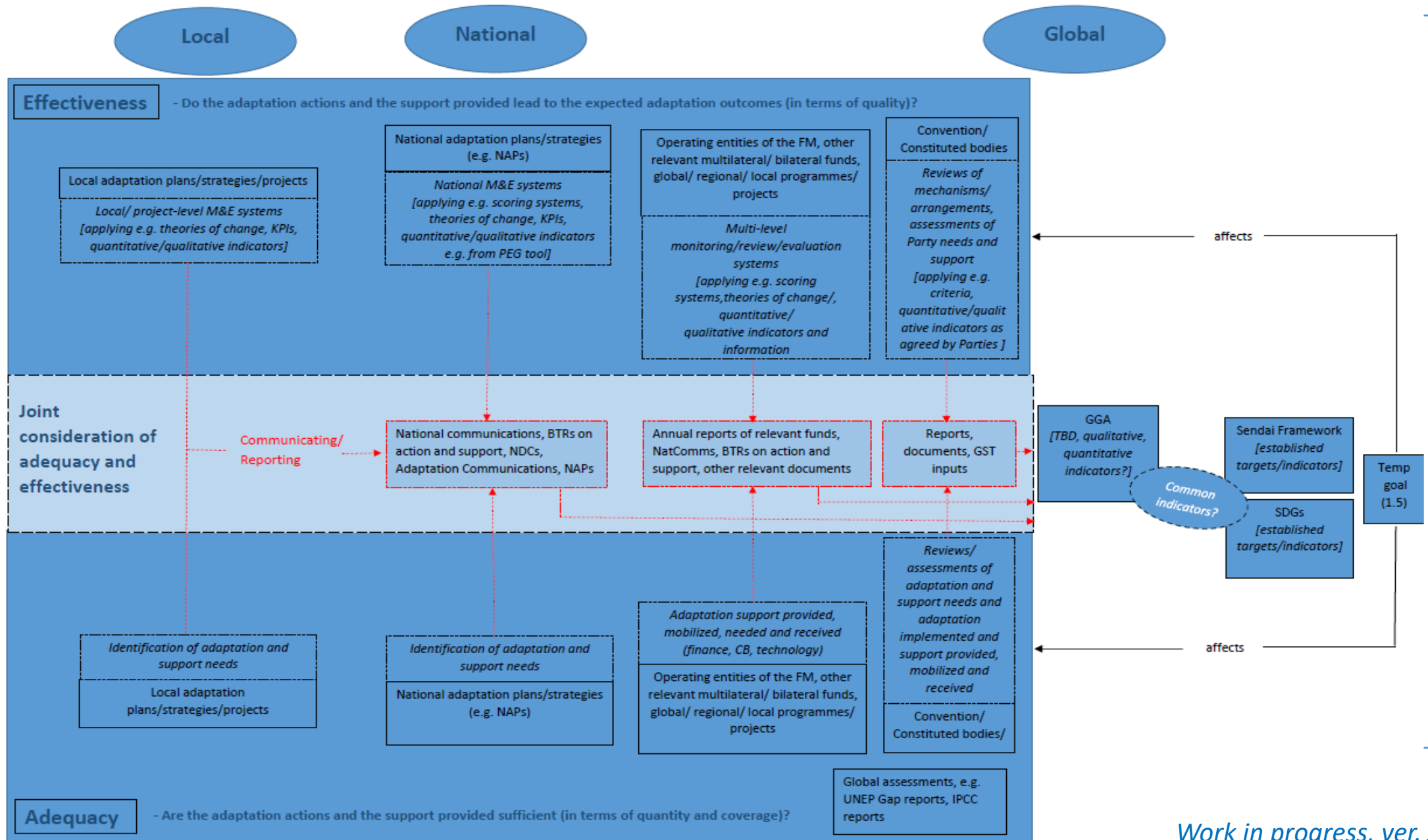

Possible review criteria (adaptation) – preliminary elements

- ❑ **Governance** (NAP guidelines, AGR 2021, AR6): e.g. existence of institutional arrangements; regulatory frameworks; adaptation plan
- ❑ **Comprehensiveness** (NAP guidelines, AGR''): e.g. trends on climate change; risk and vulnerability assessment; adaptation baseline;
- ❑ **Alignment of adaptation measures with risk and vulnerability analysis**: e.g. are adaptation measures addressing identified risks and vulnerabilities; adaptation pathways; synergies and tradeoffs
- ❑ **Implementability** (NAP guidelines, AGR 2021): e.g. clearly prioritized adaptation measures (policies, projects and programmes), cost and timeframes; theory of change; climate rationale; capacity needs for implementation; partners to support implementation
- ❑ **Transformative potential** (AR6): i.e. depth; scope; speed; and limits
- ❑ **Monitoring and evaluation** (NAP guidelines, AGR 2021, AR6): e.g. M&E systems; vision, goals and objectives; baseline; metrics and indicators.



Possible review criteria (support provided for adaptation) – preliminary draft

- ❑ **Conformity of the support with mandates:** operational policies on support in response to COP/CMA/CMP/SB mandates; alignment of support with countries' priorities and needs; enabling environments and provisions by the developing countries for mobilizing and accessing support for adaptation;
- ❑ **Accessibility:** operational policies to facilitate access to support; technical assistance to countries in need of support; prioritization of the LDCs, SIDS;
- ❑ **Impact:** evidence of enhanced adaptive capacity, *strengthened resilience and reduced vulnerability to climate change*; increased efforts in fostering *collaboration and sharing of information*; strengthened networks, partnerships and capacity-building for development and transfer of *adaptation technologies*; increased efforts of developing countries in implementing the Convention, the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement;
- ❑ **Catalytic effect:** additional sources of finance leveraged; additional technology and capacity-building mobilized



Work of the LEG in scaling up of NAPs and related targets

- Assisting all LDCs meet the target of submitting a first NAP by end 2022 or soon after;
- Assisting each LDC in accessing the GCF to implement the NAP, country specific targets for next 2 years as part of GCF country programmes;
- Assisting each LDC in accessing other funding to implement the NAP fully;
- LEG Project development writing support – **Projects Catalog of Sept 2022 published online;**
- Meeting the opportunity of doubling of adaptation finance by 2025;
- LEG co-development of technical guidelines for implementation of NAPs;
- Further development of the PEG M&E tool to expand metrics to cover outcomes and impacts of adaptation actions and the NAPs
- Launching of the “Roster of Experts” of experts from the LDCs.
