  - NAP writing workshop for Asia-Pacific LDCs from 11 to 14 July 2022, in Siem Reap, Cambodia




# Launching of the roster of LDC NAP Experts

- Composed of national and regional experts from the LDCs
- Experts with relevant skills and professional expertise in climate change adaptation who can contribute to activities related to the formulation and implementation of NAPs
- Experts will be made available to all those supporting NAPs in the LDCs to use, to promote use of nationally available experts in delivering support

# Addressing data challenges through the NAP Data Initiative

- Access to usable data, in particular climate scenario data, usually ranked high in gaps related to addressing adaptation and formulating NAPs
- In addition to climate data/scenario data, there are numerous global and regional datasets that have been meticulously put together for various (global) studies
- Managing huge datasets is cumbersome, costly, and can be daunting when conducting assessments and preparing the NAP

Overriding authority of the COP and the CMA.




