Addressing delays in producing NAPs through direct country support

- Offering comprehensive support to the LDCs in formulating and implementing NAPs through the Open NAP initiative
- Offers an opportunity for countries to select national experts to assist in drafting their NAPs
- An open process of identifying obstacles and addressing this obstacles through targeted support



Addressing issues of access to the GCF through NAP writing workshops

- The LEG facilitates the development and implementation of project proposals to improve the LDCs' access to GCF resource through the NAP writing workshops:
 - NAP writing workshop for African LDCs held from 24 to 26 March 2022, in Nairobi, Kenya
 - NAP writing workshop for Asia-Pacific LDCs from 11 to 14 July 2022, in Siem Reap, Cambodia




Launching of the roster of LDC NAP Experts

- Composed of national and regional experts from the LDCs
- Experts with relevant skills and professional expertise in climate change adaptation who can contribute to activities
 related to the formulation and implementation of NAPs
- Experts will be made available to all those supporting NAPs in the LDCs to use, to promote use of nationally available experts in delivering support

Addressing data challenges through the NAP Data Initiative

- Access to usable data, in particular climate scenario data, usually ranked high in gaps related to addressing adaptation and formulating NAPs
- In addition to climate data/scenario data, there are numerous global and regional datasets that have been meticulously put together for various (global) studies
- Managing huge datasets is cumbersome, costly, and can be daunting when conducting assessments and preparing the NAP




